

Greetings one and all.

It is with a sense of great joy that I write to announce to you the next pastor for St. James Parish, Fr. John Hemsing. His appointment by the archbishop will be effective Tuesday June 21, 2022. The specifics of his schedule at the parish will be worked out over the coming weeks. Please join me in welcoming Fr. John!



Here is a bit of background on Fr. John: He earned his Master of Divinity from Saint Francis de Sales Seminary and a Doctorate of Ministry degree from Graduate Theological Foundation, South Bend, Ind. He was ordained to the priesthood May 20, 1988. He currently serves as rector of St. Francis De Sales Seminary in Milwaukee where he has served from October 1, 2011 until the present time. Prior to his current assignment,

he served as pastor of Lumen Christi Parish, Mequon, and was pastor at St. Clare Parish, Wind Lake, from 1996-2008. Fr. John's first appointment as an associate pastor was at St. Mary Parish, Waukesha, 1993-1996. He also served as a pastoral team member at Immaculate Conception Parish, Milwaukee, from 1988-1993. Fr. Hemsing has also served the archdiocese as a member of the Archdiocesan College of Consultors, since 2005, as well as a dean, District three, from 2002-2008.

This is an exciting time in St. James Parish history. Under Fr. John's spiritual and temporal care, and with the Grace of God and guidance of the Holy Spirit, this 174 year old parish has some great years ahead!


