

TIPS ON HOW TO TALK TO YOUR KIDS ABOUT ONLINE **INTERACTIONS**

Let's face it, there are some conversations that are just going to be uncomfortable to have with your child. When you open the door to talk with your child or teen about online interactions, start with, "I remember being a kid. But I've never been a parent of a kid your age before. So please recognize that I just want to keep you safe in every way possible. That's why I wanted to talk about-----for a minute. Are you ok with that?" Use everyday experiences as prompts for conversations. Let's say your child tells you about a decision another kid made online that got him into trouble. You can respond with "Remember when we talked about choosing how we react to situations?" This is a good example of how you can decide what you'll do when that kind of thing happens to you. What do you think he or she could have done to make this turn out better?" 
