There is an immediate need for **ACOLYTES** to serve by setting a few things up prior to a Mass, assisting the presider during Mass, and then a little clean up afterwards.

The assistance of an acolyte is essential in making any service, whether it's our **weekend Masses, a wedding or funeral**, run smoothly so that everyone can participate in undistracted prayer.

We are grateful to those who serve in this ministry already for weekend Masses, Funerals & Weddings, but have a lost some of our faithful ministers for various reasons and are in great need of a few more people to help serve in this way.

SENIORS . . . If you are retired and able bodied . . .

Consider serving St. James as a **funeral acolyte** .

This is an "on-call" ministry, meaning when a funeral comes in we call our funeral acolytes to see who happens to be available on the day of the funeral.

Most funerals take place at 11:00 a.m. on a weekday, occasionally we may have a Saturday funeral.

The time commitment would be to come about 1/2 an hour before the funeral to set up, with most funerals being about an hour and then just a short time for clean up afterwards. Shadowing & training is available.

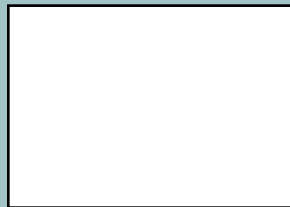

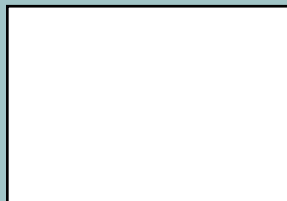
