

Matthew 25 | The Cross is Our Lenten Giving Tree

Corporal Works of Mercy: I was thirsty

Come you who have been blessed by my Father. For I was thirsty"... not for drink or refreshment...But thirsty for a word or sign of friendship or companionship.

One Simple Act: During this Lenten season, seek out someone each week who is alone or lonely and go out of your way to show some friendship or companionship to that person and spend some personal time with them.



How is God inviting you to give your life to each **other** during Lent this year?

2/18 1st Sunday of Lent

I establish my covenant with you and all living beings (Genesis 9: 8-15)

Flooding, devastation, destruction. That's what Noah witnessed and God promised would never happen again by God's hand. God loved his creatures enough to begin anew with a covenant of love and hope. Yet "the excessive amount of land and water that people are using has killed 70% of terrestrial biodiversity and 50% of freshwater biodiversity". Most of this land and water use is from agriculture. What we choose to eat and what we meant to eat but wasted instead affect our planet.

Lent is a time of fasting and abstinence from food. Hunger reminds us of our dependence on God, calls us to prayer, and spiritually connects us to those without enough to eat. But what if we go deeper still, and acknowledge the toll our food choices take on our common home?

Kate, our Lent Mentor, shares some ideas to help us decrease the strain on our Common Home:

Eat "lower on the food chain" - less red meat, choose chicken or fish.

Try a meatless vegetarian meal once or twice a week. Plan meals, eat leftovers, compost scraps like potato peels and coffee grounds. Less for the landfill!

Lent 2024

The Catholic Church asks each member to preserve the penitential character and purpose of Lent. For this reason:

Catholics who have celebrated their 14th birthday are bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and each Friday of Lent;

Catholics who have celebrated their 18th birthday, in addition to abstaining from meat, are to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Hence, on those days they may eat only one full meal. Smaller quantities of food may be taken at two other meals, but no food should be consumed at other times during those days. The obligation of fasting ceases with the celebration of one's 59th birthday.

Catholics should not lightly excuse themselves from these prescribed minimal penitential practices.


