*In 2013, Mary and Chuck Mazza (parents of Grace Mazza Urbanski, Christ King parishioner and principal of Christ King School) launched a campaign to encourage people to pray the rosary by way of a bumper sticker that says "Help America: Pray the Rosary." Grace's mom trusted that spending time with Jesus by meditating on the mysteries of the rosary would bring blessing to our country. The bumper stickers are offered free of charge to anyone who asks. So far, over 2 million people have asked (and received)!*

*Although Grace's mom died of pancreatic cancer in 2019, her dad continues the mission of prayer. Their mission reminds us that when we take time to offer our prayers to God, God listens and sends more grace into the world. Sometimes people forget that prayer is also community service.*

## **BUMPER STICKER CAMPAIGN GROWS TO STAGGERING HEIGHTS**

If anyone could convince the Lord to forgive the sins of a nation, it would be his own mother.

That's what Mary Mazza realized one evening in the summer of 2013, when she was feeling particularly defeated discussing with her family the increasing secularization of the United States, she found herself despairing over a whole host of moral crises that have cropped up in today's America, abortion chief amongst them.

"We were talking about how horrible everything is, and I said that God must be pretty mad," said Mazza, a parishioner at Saint Teresa of Calcutta Parish in North Lake. "We thought, well, what can we do? We've got to do something."

She prayed, went to bed, and by the next morning, she had her answer. "I said to (my husband) Chuck, 'I know what we have to do now. We have to advertise to pray the Rosary.'"

The couple settled on the idea of designing a bumper sticker that bore the images of an American flag, a rosary and the words "America Needs Help: Pray the Rosary." Unsure of how to go about production and distribution, Chuck Mazza made a call to the Archdiocese of Milwaukee, who connected him with Dick and Terry Boldin of the Rosary Evangelization Apostolate. Through the Boldins, they found a graphic artist and printed; and scheduled a meeting with Archbishop Jerome Listecky, who liked the idea but requested a small change in the language, suggesting it read instead, "Help America: Pray the Rosary."

The first order the Mazzas placed was for 35,000 bumper stickers, and Archbishop Listecky sent a letter to all priests in the archdiocese encouraging them to order packets, free of cost, for their parishes. "We spent

several weeks in the fall of 2013 driving around to Racine, Kenosha, Sheboygan, dropping off bumper stickers to whatever parishes had asked for them," said Mary. "And then, all of a sudden—it just burst loose." The following summer, demand for the bumper stickers skyrocketed after Archbishop Listecky sent letters to his fellow bishops of the USCCB advertising the availability of the bumper stickers. "We started getting orders from a lot of dioceses," said Chuck. "In Madison, the bishop said he wanted all his parishes to have it—we sent them 25,000. Hartford, Connecticut, took 40,000. Colorado Springs took 40,000—El Paso, Texas, did the same thing."

Before long, organizations like the American Life League and World Apostolate of Fatima heard about the stickers and placed mass orders of their own. By the end of 2014, more than one million bumper stickers had been distributed to encourage the praying of the Rosary for the sake of America.

Mary Mazza said she is pleased with the success of the evangelizing bumper stickers, but not surprised—after all, the Holy Spirit and the Blessed Mother, through the rosary, have never failed to bring sanctity to the world. "I was just very happy and blessed that they were going all over the place. It was just amazing," she said. A mother of eight and grandmother of 23, she is always being alerted to the bumper sticker ubiquity by members of her large, close-knit family. "When any of the kids see them, they leave me a message—"saw another bumper sticker:"

"In my previous job, I used to travel all around the country. Every time I would see 'Pray the

Rosary' bumper stickers, I would take a picture and send it to my parents," said the Mazzas' daughter, Grace Mazza Urbanski. "I had to kick the habit after a while because it took too much time—the bumper stickers are everywhere."

"It's awesome to see," said the Mazzas' son, Dave. "We always look at the license plate so we can see how far mom and dad's message and work have spread"

To date, more than 1.5 million have been produced and distributed—25,000 in just the first three months of this year. Six hundred thousand have gone to parishes throughout 48 states. Holy Hill alone has handed out more than 35,000. Every packet of 250 3.5-inch-by-11.5-inch bumper stickers ship free of cost

to the recipient, hand-mailed by the Mazzas themselves, who along with another anonymous benefactor, have subsidized the expense of all production and shipping. Requests for the packets are routed through the Rosary Evangelization Apostolate.

"She's the artist in the family—she gets the great ideas, and I'm just the numbers grunt," said Chuck. "So I look at those numbers and I think, if every bumper sticker generates just ten rosaries—right there, that's fifteen million rosaries."

And as much as anyone, Mary Mazza knows the power of that simple prayer—she has maintained a steadfast devotion to it throughout the many trials of life, including the loss of two of her children (a

daughter, Catherine, at the age of four, and a son, Mark, at the age of 39). But Urbanski said that her mother also recognizes that, more than being just a source of personal comfort, the rosary is a powerful tool—a wellspring of holiness in a sinful world.

"She is 100 percent certain that, when we take time to offer our prayers to God, God listens and sends more grace into the world," Urbanski said "Sometimes people forget that prayer is community service, too. Mom's bumper stickers remind us that prayer fuels all our service to others."

"It's always been that way with me," said Mary. "When bad things happen, you grab the beads."







## Sacraments:

### Infant Baptism

Baptism is an initiation into a new life of discipleship and access to the full spiritual riches of the Church. The parish rejoices at the gift of new life and seeks to assist you in this mission as parents, starting with the sacramental grace of Baptism. Preparation sessions are held regularly among our tri-parish collaborative relationship. For the convenience of parents, we encourage you to begin preparation prior to the birth of the child. Baptisms are celebrated on particular Sundays of the month either during Mass or after Mass. Contact the parish office for details.
