MARRIAGES

By appointment with priest at least 6 months in advance. You must be a registered member of the parish. Weddings are not scheduled during Lent.

SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION

The Sacrament of Reconciliation is available after the 8:15 AM Mass on Saturdays. Confessions are heard in the North Cry Room with the option of using a confessional screen or sitting face-to-face socially distanced from the priest. Those waiting for confession should line up in the center aisle of the church while maintaining social distance.

Reception of the Sacrament may also be requested by calling the parish office to make an appointment. Arrangements will be made for either the pastor or one of the resident Nigerian priests to assist you.

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Parents of children for Baptism should be registered parish members. Contact Gary Heun to register and to schedule a date. Parent instruction class is required before Baptism. Classes are held on the first Wednesday evening of odd-numbered months.

Installation of Fr. Michael Erwin as Pastor ***July 17, 2021, 5:00 PM Mass***

It is tradition in the Catholic Church that if possible, a bishop would ritually install a new pastor early in his pastorate. This is meant to make clear the Holy Orders that guide this transition but is also a great opportunity to physically and spiritually make a connection between the bishop, his parishes, and priests.

We welcome Archbishop ListECKi as he presides at this liturgy.

Church: School for the Strong

To further orient myself into St. Jude Parish, I have begun reading a book containing many of Monsignor Holleran's important talks and insights. The title of this book is *No Trumpets Before Him*.

Before Fr. Holleran began his 25-year pastorate at St. Jude Parish, he led the marriage preparation process for the Archdiocese called *Cana*. He was known for not presenting marriage as being too simple; instead he stated: "Marriage is not a refuge for the weak but a school for the strong."

Indeed, much that is good in life requires hard work, a sense of adventure, and the possibility of failure or embarrassment. In today's gospel reading, the disciples are sent out two by two with no great purse of money, fancy clothes, or the like. What they bring with them is the instruction to forgive people. They are told that people might reject them and were given further instructions to shake the dust off of their feet and move on if this happens.

Many of us enjoy the aspects of church that allow us to unload a burden and find calm by prayerfully centering with scripture and the various liturgies. This relaxing part of church is important as Jesus often went off to pray and St. Francis of Assisi spent almost half of his time in prayer.

We need to also be a people of action and work to spread this good news through the forgiveness of sins. The only way for us to talk about sins (the messiness of life) is to really get outside of ourselves which takes a lot of work.

May you find a way to be active in the church through our school, faith formation and human concerns ministries. May you find a way to experience the annoying mistakes of others and forgive them first in your heart and if necessary with your lips. May you have the joy of making a mistake, and though very difficult, doing the work of honestly apologizing to others.
