

#### SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION

The Sacrament of Reconciliation is available after the 8:15 AM Mass on Saturdays. Confessions are heard in the North Cry Room with the option of using a confessional screen or sitting face-to-face socially distanced from the priest. Those waiting for confession should line up in the center aisle of the church while maintaining social distance.

Reception of the Sacrament may also be requested by calling the parish office to make an appointment. Arrangements will be made for either the pastor or one of the resident Nigerian priests to assist you.

Parents of children for Baptism should be registered parish members. Contact Gary Heun to register and to schedule a date. Parent instruction class is required before Baptism. Classes are held on the first Wednesday evening of odd-numbered months.

## Jesus Teaches Resilience

After an affirming summer of Jesus teaching discipleship; two weeks ago he had to sit us down and teach us our number one weakness – blame shifting. If something goes wrong we try to find a way to not admit our part of the problem. This blame shifting can get out of control in addictions and is part of the breakdown of relationships.

Last week Jesus taught us that he can heal us so as to restore communication. He can heal our ears so we can hear again, and our mouths that we can begin speaking again.

Jesus follows this good news with more bad news. Just because we are healed doesn't mean the world is healed. Therefore Jesus teaches us resilience so we don't give up and thus stop working (see our second reading about works and faith). How does Jesus help us? First by normalizing the maltreatment we receive - even the Son of God is treated badly on a regular basis and eventually on the cross. So what is our response? We need to accept our cross that doing good is not rewarded with positive feedback. People might hurt us even as we are trying to help them.

We do not want to backslide and lose our faith or lose ourselves by assigning blame. This human response often gets us going in circles. On this weekend we are remembering September 11 and thinking about our quick withdrawal from Afghanistan after 20 years of the combination of war and nation building. Perhaps we have just perpetuated the problem and gone in a giant circle. This is exactly Jesus' point. When do we wish to leave our human ways of handling situations and try God's way?

True discipleship requires us to keep the faith even when it gets difficult, to accept our part of the problem, to ask for healing for ourselves personally, and to try again even though we may not get positive feedback. This is the Jesus model of resilience. *Fr. Michael Erwin*


