### MARRIAGES

By appointment with priest at least 6 months in advance. You must be a registered member of the parish. Weddings are not scheduled during Lent.

### SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION

The Sacrament of Reconciliation is available after the 8:15 AM Mass on Saturdays. Confessions are heard in the North Cry Room with the option of using a confessional screen or sitting face-to-face socially distanced from the priest. Those waiting for confession should line up in the center aisle of the church while maintaining social distance.

Reception of the Sacrament may also be requested by calling the parish office to make an appointment. Arrangements will be made for either the pastor or one of the resident Nigerian priests to assist you.

### SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Parents of children for Baptism should be registered parish members. Contact Gary Heun to register and to schedule a date. Parent instruction class is required before Baptism. Classes are held on the first Wednesday evening of odd-numbered months.

## The Necessary Body of Christ

As we have gone through COVID and used our technology more to communicate, we wonder if we will go back to meeting in person. We probably will meet in person again because we communicate more thoroughly when we use our whole body. Using only our eyes or ears, or even our face, is an incomplete communication.

In our *Letter to the Hebrews* today the first sentence quotes from *Psalms 40* but makes one important change. *Psalms 40* states that “God will prepare an ear for me”, when *Hebrews* states “God is preparing a body for me”. God could have continued saying gentle messages through our hearts but that would not sufficiently communicate what we need to understand. Instead God sent the Christ incarnate in a body. With this incarnation Jesus was able to touch the sick, walk during travels, eat with the disciples and sinners, and look with love upon someone who struggled with the sacrificial call. Most importantly Jesus gave up his body on the cross to forgive our sins and assure us that his body will be with us at the Mass.

On another note, if we went through two years of COVID with less physical contact, and therefore a thinner form of communication, we might feel overwhelmed by the full communication we give one another in person. Jesus not only heals our ears and eyes but the wholeness of our relationships for these times we meet in person – and he did so by saving us in person.


