## DEACON DAVE'S DESK

This Sunday we are celebrating the Epiphany of the Lord. Jesus Christ manifests himself to the world. St. Paul in his Letter to the Ephesians says it well, "It has now been revealed to his holy apostles and prophets by the Spirit: that the Gentiles are coheirs, members of the same body, and copartners in the promise in Christ Jesus through the gospel. (Ephesians 3:2-6) Christ Jesus has come to save all peoples, not just a chosen few.

In fact, those who should have rejoiced that God has come into the world are "greatly troubled." Not only are King Herod and the people of Jerusalem greatly troubled, they are planning to kill the Savior of the world. Even as an infant, Jesus must flee for his life. Even now, we live in a world that wants to attack and destroy what is good. We live in a world that bows before evil and materialism.

Jesus Christ came to free us from sin and death and the world's response is sin and death. The Magi from the East were Gentiles who came to the Savior of the world through the wonder of God's creation, the Star in the Heavens. Herod had the opportunity to join the Magi and bow before the newborn King and Savior of the universe. Instead, Herod orders the killing of all the boys in and around Bethlehem to destroy this usurper to Herod's earthly throne. May our Lord Jesus Christ, King and Savior, help us to remain strong in our faith in spite of persecution, suffering and death.

May we echo the Collect Prayer of Epiphany:

May the splendor of your majesty, O Lord, we pray, shed its light upon our hearts, that we may pass through the shadows of this world and reach the brightness of our eternal home. Through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, for ever and ever. Amen.
