1. God's Call

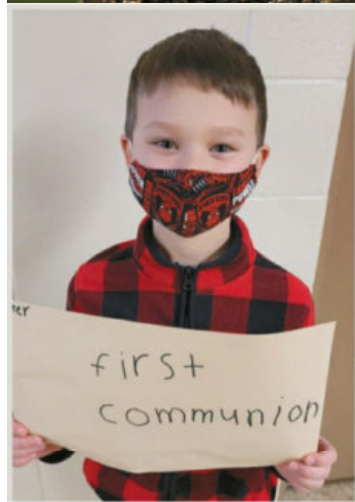
