Below is a letter from Nico to the parish. Nico is studying and preparing for the priesthood at the Vatican and is one of our parishioners. Dear St. Paul Parish Family,

I pray that you are all doing during this great season of Lent as the Lord draws our hearts more closely to His own in preparation for the celebration of His victory of death on Easter Sunday! I wanted to write to thank you for your continued prayers and support and to update you on my seminary year thus far in Rome.

In December, I received Christmas cards from many of you, which was such a great joy! I've found that it is always helpful to have reminders of home in seminary, whether I've been in Milwaukee or Rome. It is a reminder for me that I have been called to love and serve the people of the Green Bay Diocese, but even more than that, it is a reminder that I have come from a particular place and people that have loved and supported me in my faith through the witness to the love of Christ and the reception of the Sacraments. Know that all of you are in my prayers!

My parents, Mike and Stephanie Murray, have kept me up to date about various things going on at the parish, and it brought me great joy to hear about the success of the second live nativity production. What a great witness to the community of the joy of the Incarnation of Jesus!

It's almost hard for me to begin to recount the blessings of this year so far in Rome, which I suppose is a blessing in itself. When I came over, I was sent to Siena to study Italian because my theology classes are all taught in Italian. I was placed with a great group of guys from my class who have remained some of my best friends over here. In Siena – and almost everywhere I've been here – we were surrounded by so many saints. I loved visiting the house of St. Catherine of Siena and venerating her relics in the local Dominican church.

At the beginning of the year, I was able to sing in the choir at the diaconate ordination for my brothers here in the house, which took place at St. Peter's Basilica. Our choir director described it like having to sing outside because the Basilica is so huge!

The school year kicked off in early October, and I have loved studying theology. It is amazing to discover the richness of the faith through theology classes, many of which have provided me with beautiful things to pray with. My favorite class was on the Pentateuch, the first five books of the bible. Our professor moved beautifully through all the books, essentially giving a homily each class about the narrative of the story. It opened my heart to love Scripture even more.

Another highlight was definitely meeting Pope Francis. It was kind of surreal being in the same room as him and getting a turn to greet him and shake his hand. He addressed all of us together and told us to care for our souls through prayer and staying close to Mary, and to care for our body by making time to exercise! Every time we go to Mass, we pray for "Francis our Pope," and meeting him in person certainly made that prayer more concrete for me.

While it has been difficult being farther away from home, this time in Rome has helped me draw even closer to the heart of Jesus. It has been such a blessed time that I cannot thank God enough for, and I look forward to the day where – please God – I may be ordained a priest of Jesus Christ for the Diocese of Green Bay. The community here is a great blessing, and I am surrounded by so many saints, right here in the heart of the Church.

Let's pray for each other, that we may all let God reign in our hearts!


