AS WE GATHER The pages of Scripture counsel us regarding things that are not to be neglected. Proverbs says plainly: “Hear instruction and be wise, and do not neglect it” (Proverbs 8:33). Paul writes to young Timothy: “Do not neglect the gift you have, which was given you by prophecy when the council of elders laid their hands on you” (1 Timothy 4:14). But the book of the Bible with the most reminders about what is not to be neglected is Hebrews. Here we are directed: do not neglect to do good (Hebrews 13:16), do not neglect to show hospitality (13:2), do not neglect to meet together (10:25), and do not neglect our great salvation (2:3). We do well to take that divine guidance to heart.

Immanuel already is feeling like home! Thank you so much for the warm and kind welcome for my family! The love and gifts have been so overwhelming! We have been so very blessed by you and would like to encourage you in keeping that spirit growing! Consider where you might grow alongside us so that all our Immanuel family and friends experience that loving welcome from Jesus's people!

Through October, I'd like to challenge you in this growth by considering Immanuel +1. If you are attending worship once a month, attend twice! If you are attending worship each week, attend a Bible study as well. 





An election will be held during the annual meeting on one of the first two Sundays in December.

Vice-President: Fulfills the President's duties in his/her absence and chairs the Nominating Committee (Not up for election this year)
