## Deacon Jeff's Corner

Welcome to 2022; times here on earth sure flies, doesn't it?

On January 1<sup>st</sup> every year, we celebrate the Solemnity of Mary, Holy Mother of God, who is also the patron saint of the Americas. The name "Mother of God" has some history, as the early Christians wrestled with the idea of calling her *Theotokos*, meaning "God bearer". Or was she just a simple vessel to deliver a child who then became the God of the Universe? 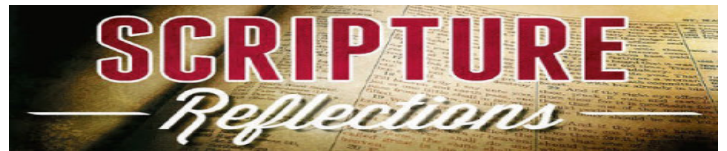

**Epiphany Moment**

Have you ever experienced an epiphany moment? An "Aha" moment that gives you that feeling of a sudden revelation or insight into something's true meaning? Not long ago while working with someone who would be receiving the Sacraments of Initiation for the first time, I mentioned that the Eucharist is the real presence of Jesus. It is Jesus - Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity. His eyes lit up! The experience still brings goosebumps thinking about it. What an epiphany realizing that what you will soon receive IS ACTUALLY JESUS!

Likewise, can you imagine the Magi leaving everything to follow a star in search of the newborn King? Imagine following a light that led them directly to the child Jesus. What an epiphany that must have been! They knelt before Him offering not only gifts, but a sign of love, devotion, and reverence.
