





The Salvation of St. Dismas

Although it is nearly Advent, in today's Gospel we journey back into Christ's Passion. The encounter between Jesus and the two criminals who die with Him always amazes and enthralls me. In different seasons of my life, I've been able to identify with each of them.

As we enter into times of suffering, the devil is very good at finding an angle to put our faith to the test. The age old question, "Why does God allow bad things to happen?" comes forth. Like the first criminal, we may be tempted to demand a sign or an answer from God. We may bargain with Him, or even become angry with Him. He hears you. And even if your prayers may not be answered in the way you had hoped, He is suffering with you.

And then there is "the Good Thief". Sacred tradition gives him the name Dismas. I marvel at his reaction to the horrific death they are about to endure. What had he heard about Jesus to inspire such a faith? Or maybe, had he met Jesus before? However he came about it, his faith, like ours, is truly a gift. He recognizes his sinfulness and yet in Christ crucified he knows God's mercy. He doesn't seek to avoid suffering. Instead, he *enters into suffering* with Jesus. He asks only to be remembered in the kingdom of Heaven that is to come.

Throughout all salvation history, God sees us, hears us, and remembers us. We know from the cross that our suffering is not meaningless. There is no trial too big or too small to offer up to our Lord. With humble acknowledgement of our sins and trust in God's mercy, we can take the path of Dismas and hope to join the saints with Jesus in Paradise.
