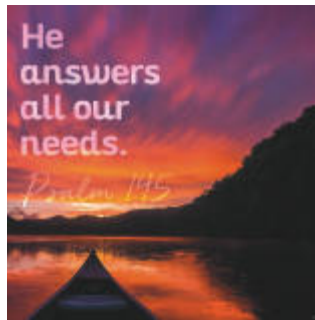
This week in scripture -

Human Concerns/Community Outreach - We continue to see steady usage at our Blessings Box behind the church and need your ongoing assistance keeping food in stock. Please drop off ready to eat meals, cereals, easy open canned food, and vegetables to help those in need. You can drop off here at church or at ANY local mini pantry when you see them around, there are a dozen in Walworth County now. There are 84 families currently on the waiting list for emergency shelter at Twin Oaks and many more on the brink, and of course the men's homeless shelter doesn't operate until late in the fall. You can help insure that our friends and neighbors do not go hungry. Anything your family would eat for a quick meal or snacks is perfect for the Blessings Box we will take one item or a hundred. As a reminder EBT (food stamps) will not pay for personal hygiene or cleaning supplies so they are always welcome and appreciated. 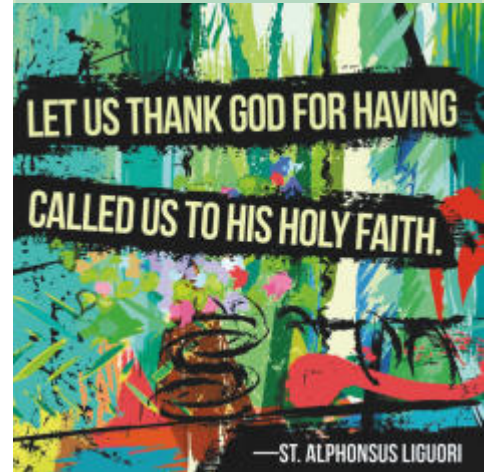

SAN PATRICIO (MINISTERIO HISPANO)

XVII DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO

"Aquí hay un muchacho que trae cinco panes de cebada y dos pescados". (Jn 6,1-15)

¡Habiendo dado gracias a Dios, los repartió!

El milagro de la multiplicación de los panes es el único que aparece en los cuatro evangelios. La razón principal es que se ve como una anticipación de la Última Cena y de la celebración de la Eucaristía. La lectura contiene gestos realizados por Jesús que hoy asociamos con la Eucaristía: *"Tomó el pan, dio gracias, y lo repartió"*.



En la última cena, Jesús compartió con sus amigos el "Pan de Vida"; en esta escena, instruye a sus discípulos a que ellos alimenten a la multitud. Cuando Juan escribió su Evangelio (90-100 d.C.), el gesto de Jesús alimentando a la multitud tenía un doble mensaje:

1- *La Eucaristía era una fuente inagotable de alimento;*

2- *Los líderes de las comunidades tenían la responsabilidad de alimentar al pueblo, especialmente con la prédica y la Eucaristía.*

En el Padre Nuestro rogamos a Dios que nos de lo que necesitamos para poder seguir trabajando por el Reino. Hoy, también somos enviados alimentar a los que tienen hambre corporal y espiritual.

El pan material que Dios nos concede nos recuerda lo que debemos compartir con tantos hombres y mujeres que están faltos de recursos y que luchan desesperadamente por un trozo de pan.

Cuando rezas "danos hoy nuestro pan de cada día;" luchamos por saciar el hambre material. Hambre que nos ayuda a relativizar tantos problemas que nos parecen más grandes que nosotros y a vivir más serenamente preocupándonos sólo de lo esencial.

- El pan se multiplica porque alguien "muy pequeño" renuncia a lo poco que tenía para sí.

- Todo pan que se comparte solidariamente se multiplica por el poder de Dios.

- Este milagro refleja la fe de los judíos en un Dios providencial. La diferencia es que Jesús no permite que los discípulos simplemente "observen", sino que los hace participar.

El "muchacho del evangelio se fía de Jesús, aún cuando él no había prometido nada. Los panes son pocos y los peces menos, pero pasando por las manos de Jesús todo se convierte en grande. Hay una desproporción entre lo que somos y lo que Dios nos hace llegar a ser, si nos ponemos en sus manos. "Nada es imposible para Dios".

Para reflexionar:

1- ¿Qué te dice la actitud del joven? ¿Comparto de lo que tengo con los necesitados? ¿Crees y confías en Jesús aun cuando todo parece que está en contra?

2- ¿Cómo ayudo a satisfacer la sed y el hambre espiritual que tantos sufren hoy?
