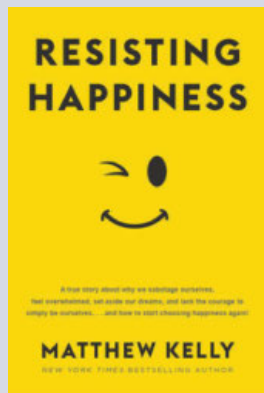

New Year's Resolutions: Thinking about growing in your faith in 2022? One way to do that is to make use of the many books we have on our shelves in the Gathering Area that are free for the taking. A generous parishioner has donated copies of "Resisting Happiness". There is a resistance that stands between you and happiness. This book helps to not only recognize it, but to conquer it. Pick up a couple copies – one for yourself and one to share with someone else! They are on the table in the Gathering Area.



REMINDER – YEAR END GIVING

The parish will close its books for the 2021 calendar year on December 31st. IRS requires that in order for your gifts to be counted toward 2021 giving, they must be delivered to the parish on or before December 31, 2021. Any checks that are written, mailed and postmarked in 2021 will be considered as 2021 giving, even though they may not be received by the parish until 2022. Any checks received the weekend of January 2/3 but dated 2021 will be considered a donation for 2022.

It continues to be brought to our attention that some of our very own parishioners have received an email or text message that looks to be from Father Oriol. The email/texting phishing scam targeting parishes and schools continues to occur, with emails or text messages supposedly being sent by the pastor (other staff member or parishioner). The body of the message usually indicates that the pastor "needs your help," directing the reader to contact "him" right away. Please be aware that this is a scam, some things to look for in the email are: **The email address is different from Father's typical address; subject lines that do not match the content of the message; and bad grammar or illogical text Father Oriol will NEVER text or email you asking for money in any way, shape or form.** Please if you receive an email that looks to be suspicious **DO NOT send money or gift cards** instead send it to office@stpatrickselkhorn.org to verify if its "real" you can always call the parish office with questions. Also note that anytime you send in a blurb to be submitted in the bulletin and it contains your cell phone number or email, it is VERY likely that you will be receiving these scam messages. The parish email and/or phone number can always be the contact info or simply a landline where a text message cannot be sent to. If you have any questions, please feel free to reach out to us.

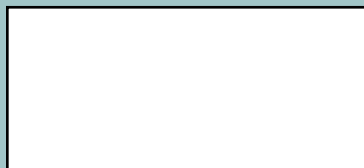

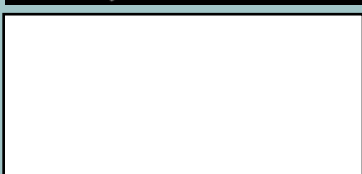

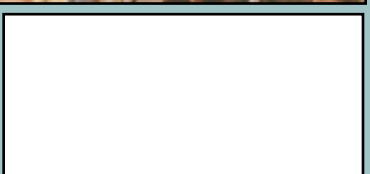
