

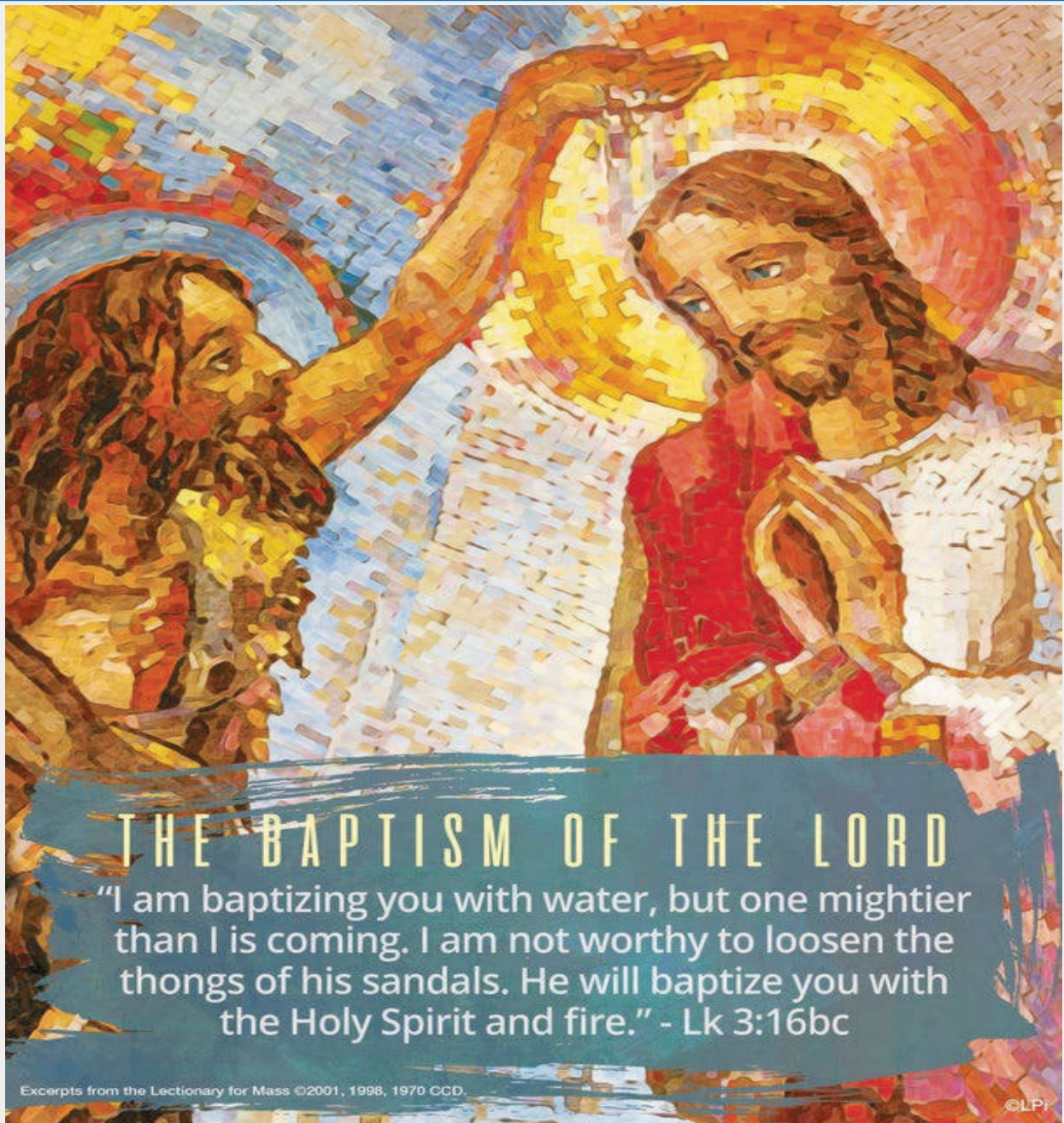

Or: Is. 42:1-4, 6-7

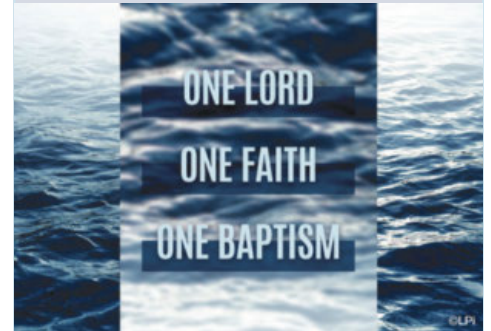
Through his son, God has given us the path to salvation. Amid all trials, tribulations, and torments we have only to follow the way.

“Jesús nos deja la grandeza del Bautismo”

El evangelio de hoy es parecido a los evangelios de Marcos y Mateo, pero Lucas resalta como Jesús se sumerge en el agua del río y como se pone en oración.

Jesús a pesar de ser el Hijo de Dios quiere parecerse tanto a nosotros que se bautiza, recibe el agua que libera y da vida. Pero antes, se pone en oración, porque para Él la relación con el Padre es necesaria.

Para nosotros el Bautismo debería ser una celebración importante porque nos abre al Espíritu de Dios y nos lleva a vivir la esperanza, el amor, la certeza de que nuestra vida cambiará porque nos sentimos libres para vivir y transitar sin miedo por la vida.

Hemos convertido el Bautismo en un acto social, le hemos quitado su importancia como encuentro personal con Dios a través del Espíritu, vivir el evangelio y hacernos con nuestra experiencia de fe mensajeros de la Palabra de Dios.

El Bautismo no debe ser impuesto porque quién lo recibe acepta unas normas de convivencia donde deben primar los valores del amor, la paz, la justicia, la comprensión, el respeto, etc.

Por eso, cuando los padres deciden bautizar a sus hijos deberían ser conscientes de la importancia de este Sacramento en la vida del bautizado y no convertirlo en un mero acto social.

- No debemos olvidar que la oración es parte esencial en nuestra vida, porque la oración es aliento, cercanía y comunicación entre nosotros y Dios.

- El Bautismo nos envía a ser portadores del mensaje del Reino de Dios.

1. En este día del bautismo del Señor: Como cristianos que somos, estamos llamados a recordar que aún después de diciembre 25, cada día es Navidad y Dios se manifiesta de nuevo entre nosotros.

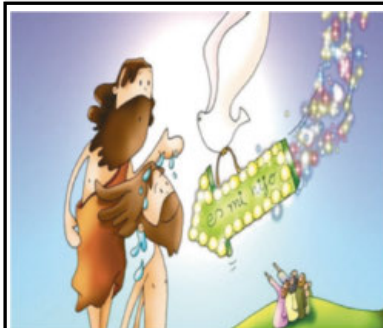
Él los bautizará con Espíritu Santo y fuego».

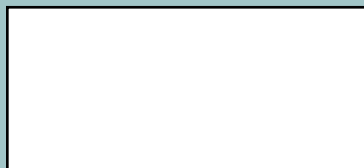

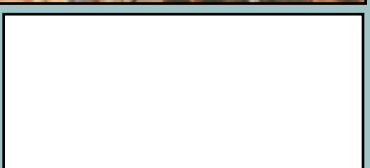
