

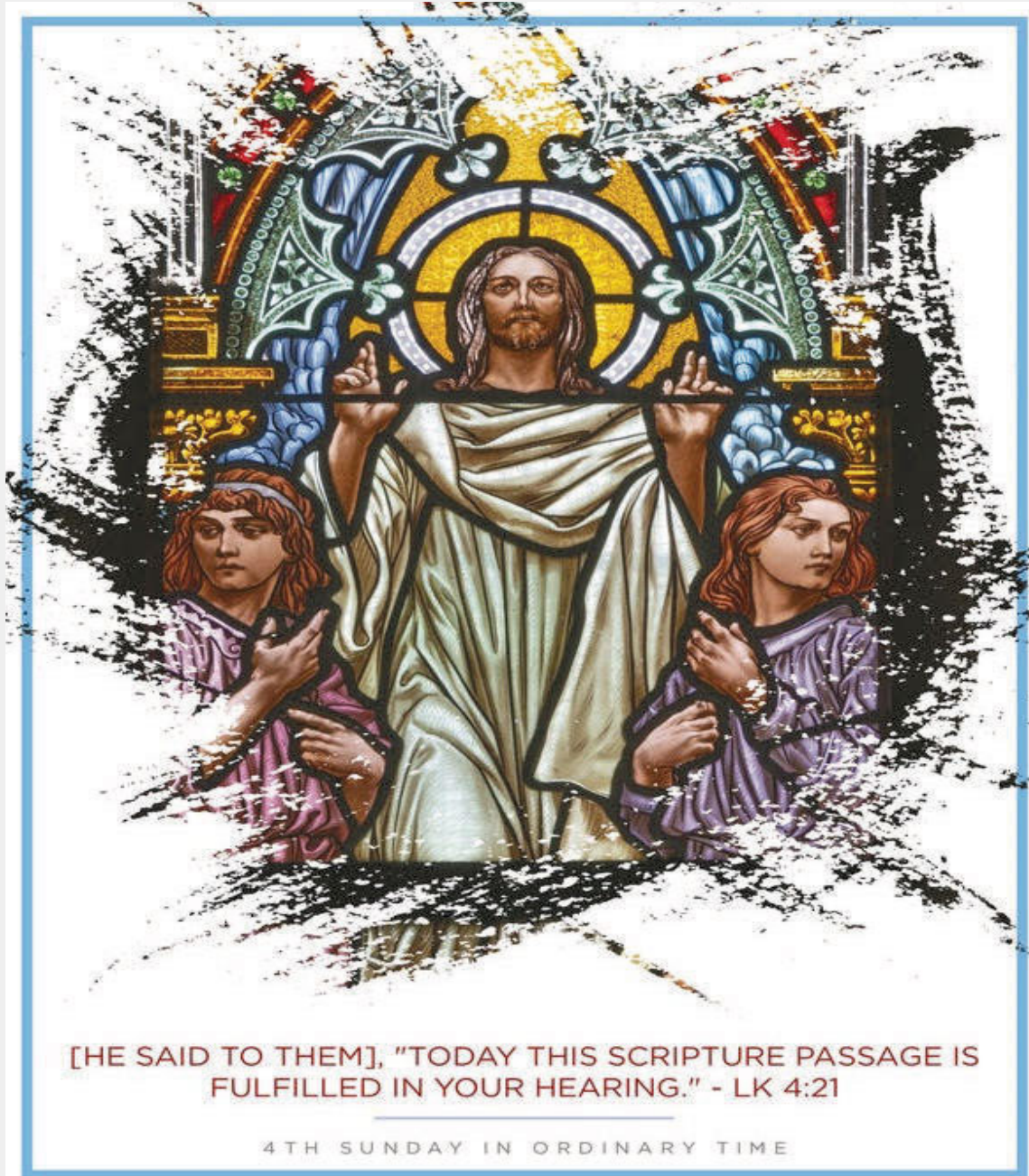

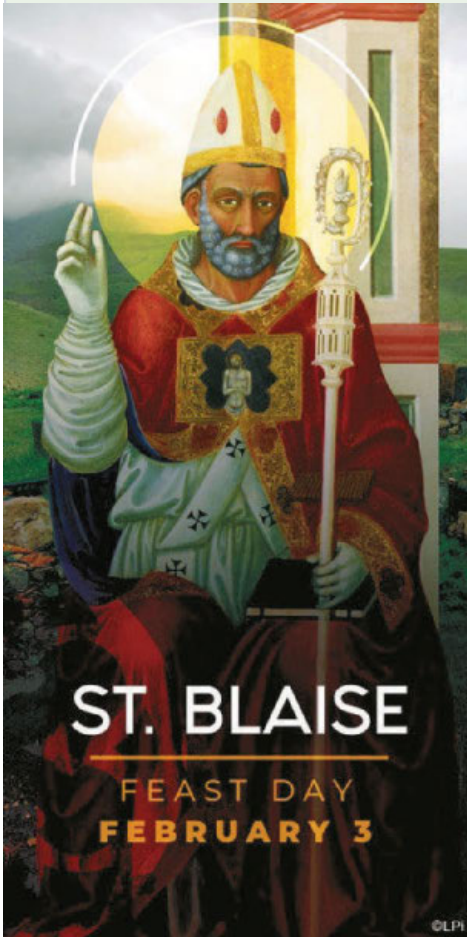

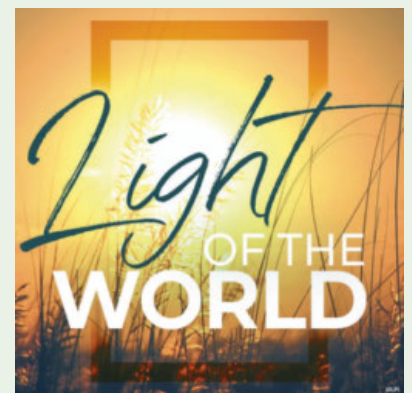

IV Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

«¿No es éste el hijo de José?» (Lucas 4:21-30)

¡Nadie es profeta en su tierra!

En el evangelio de hoy, San Lucas nos habla de cómo Jesús en su primera manifestación pública entusiasma a los oyentes, pero acto seguido nos dice que cuando descubren que es el hijo del carpintero, lo rechazan, lo dejan de lado. Para su propio pueblo no puede ser un profeta, un enviado de Dios. La gente «Daban testimonio de él»; «admiración» «palabras de gracia» y rechazo. Si caemos en cuenta hoy sigue pasando igual, nos cuesta trabajo creer en un Dios liberador que se manifiesta de la forma más sencilla, que no viene sobre un trono ni es un potentado importante, ni un religioso de élite, tampoco un hacedor de milagros, sino que Dios a través de su Hijo, se hace presente en los oprimidos y en todos aquellos que viven en soledad y marginados. Jesús es quién nos acerca la Buena Noticia, la salvación, quién nos ayuda y anima a trabajar por un mundo más justo y humano, donde todos tengamos una vida digna y llena de amor.

No nos dejemos arrastrar por restaurar una iglesia de ritos, ni por una sociedad que olvida la presencia de Dios en su vida dándole la espalda cada día, porque Jesús al igual que en su tierra terminará por irse, ser profeta en otras tierras abiertas a recibir y vivir la Palabra. Jesús, al marcharse, marcó el camino por donde deben transitar todos los que deseen seguirle. Recordemos que nadie es profeta en su tierra, en nuestro caso llenemos nuestra mente y corazón para recibir al verdadero Profeta, Jesús, Hijo de Dios.

- **A Jesús lo empujaban:** porque decir la verdad duele, molesta, incomoda, es importante que tu y yo también aprendamos a aceptar la verdad y recordar que en esta vida, todos los días debemos cambiar algo en nosotros; y si nos lo recuerdan agradecer. *¡Una linda semana a todos! vive y comparte tu fe.*

Para reflexionar:

- Tú y yo estamos llamados a ser otros Cristos en esta tierra. ¿Somos testimonio y salen palabras de gracia para los demás?



La Presentación Del Señor

“Mis Ojos Han Visto La Salvación”

- La fiesta de la presentación del Señor en el templo se enmarca dentro de las epifanías de Navidad y en ella, las figuras de Simeón y Ana, figuras llenas de valor simbólico.
- Ellos tienen la tarea del reconocimiento, que proviene tanto de la iluminación y del movimiento del Espíritu, como también de una vida llevada en la espera más intensa y confiada. Por eso en el evangelio, estos dos ancianos tienen la sabiduría que dan los años para reconocer la luz, para decir una palabra adecuada, para confiar y confiarse a Dios.
- Jesús, “Luz que alumbró a todas las naciones”, no cualquier luz, sino la luz que ilumina nuestro corazón y nuestra vida. Por eso, tenemos que reconocer que si Él nos faltase, las tinieblas se adueñarían de nuestro corazón.
- En el evangelio vemos como “este niño trae la paz”, don esencial para la existencia humana. Paz que adquiere rostros de: libertad, justicia, verdad, solidaridad, respeto y fraternidad.
- Con fe profunda, pidamos el don de la paz, paz para las familias, paz en todos los pueblos, paz en nuestra vida y paz para aquellos lugares donde se requiere una pronta solución.
- **A la luz del evangelio hoy nos preguntamos ¿soy capaz de “esperar” y reconocer la presencia de Dios en mi vida? ¿En qué medida, El Señor es la luz de mi existencia?**

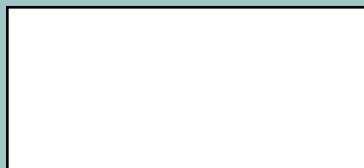

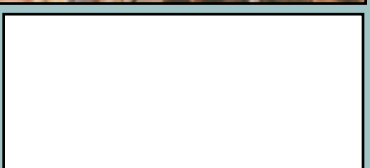
