



HAPPY AND BLESSED EASTER

St. John Paul II in his Apostolic visit to Australia in November 1986, said, "We do not pretend that life is all beauty. We are aware of darkness and sin, of poverty and pain. But we know Jesus has conquered sin and passed through his own pain to the glory of the Resurrection. And we live in the light of his Paschal Mystery - the mystery of his Death and Resurrection. "We are an Easter People and Alleluia is our song!". We are not looking for a shallow joy but rather a joy that comes from faith, that grows through unselfish love, that respects the 'fundamental duty of love of neighbor, without which it would be unbecoming to speak of Joy". We realize that joy is demanding; it demands unselfishness."

I thought about this message of St. John Paul II, thinking about the pains of the pandemic we have experienced since 2020; however as we celebrate this Easter, some light and joy is beginning to shine.
