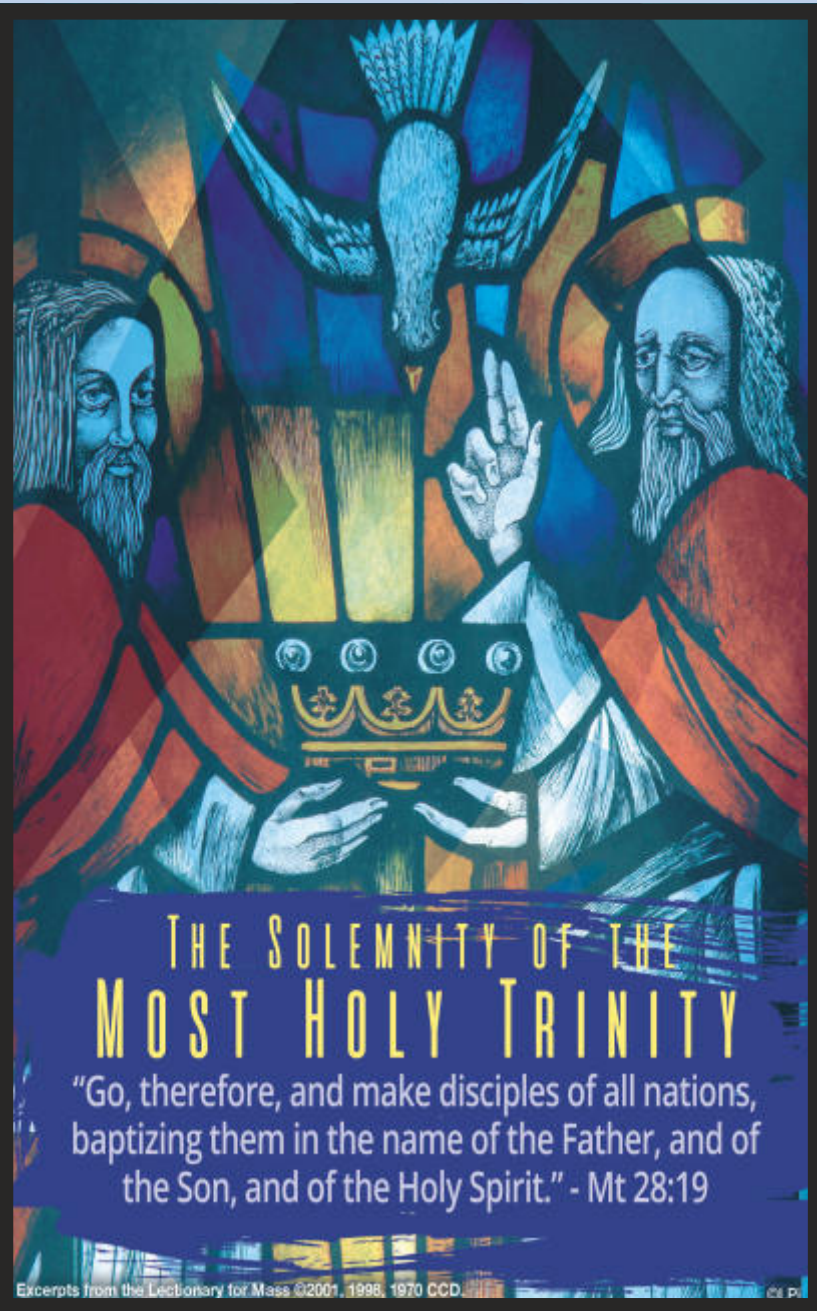
Christian Stewardship

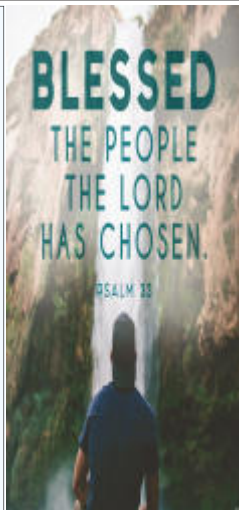

From Your Pastor

The Most Holy Trinity Sunday

As Jesus says farewell to his disciples, he instructs them to baptize “in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.” At Baptism, we were baptized with the same words. God the Father, whom Moses extols in the first reading (Deuteronomy 4: 32-34), God the Son, who calls us to discipleship in the Gospel (Matthew 28:16-20), and God the Holy Spirit, who Paul says bears witness to our adoption as children of God (Romans 8: 14-17), mark our identity as Christians. We are reminded of this Trinity every time we make the sign of the cross. Listening to God’s word in the scripture, let us reflect on the wonders God has done and continues to do in our daily lives.

MEMORIAL DAY WEEKEND

This Memorial Day weekend we remember all those who gave their lives in wars and other hostilities. These are our sons and daughters, our brothers and sisters, our fathers and mothers whose lives were tragically cut short in violent conflict. Let us as we remember them, also call to mind those who lost their lives due to COVID-19 enemy. May our prayers today connect us with those who are no longer with us. Memorial Day Mass will be celebrated at 8:30 a.m, Monday, May 31, 2021 at the Henry Catholic cemeteries. FACE MASKS MANDATE
