*From Your Pastor***12th Sunday in Ordinary Time (Father's Day weekend)**

**EASE OF PANDEMIC RESTRICTIONS**

Pursuant to the State of Illinois entering Phase 5, of lifting the restrictions that had been issued due to the pandemic, the diocese of Peoria through the Office of the Vicar General sent us this guideline: "Entering phase 5 does not mean that there are no health risks involved with our gathering together with one another – there are always risks whenever we are acting within the human community. But we have reached a point where it is reasonable for people to resume 'normal activity'. By now, people are generally aware that there are risks involved and each will have to decide for himself or herself how quickly and how deeply to reengage in the activities of life".
