#### **Epiphany of the Lord**

Though Jerusalem had been laid waste by the invading Babylonian army and the Israelites were just beginning to return there, in the first reading (Isaiah 60: 1-6), Isaiah foresaw the day when the Jerusalem would draw people and riches from near and far. The psalmist (Psalm 72) proclaims that all nations will adore God, for justice and peace will flower throughout the land. In the second reading (Ephesians 3: 2-3a, 5-6).
