



From Your Pastor

#### **Second Sunday in Ordinary Time**

Ordinary Time began on Monday January 10, and continues through Tuesday March 1, the day before Ash Wednesday and the beginning of the Lenten season. It resumes when the Easter Season ends, that is, on Monday June, 6, the day following Pentecost. As we begin Ordinary Time Season, the readings of this Sunday, reveal the transformative effect God has upon the world. Isaiah 62: 1-5 prophesied that God would transform the Israelites and their land from "forsaken" to "espoused," as a suitor rejoices in his bride. Paul (1 Corinthians 12: 4 -11) extols the gifts of the Holy Spirit, which transform each person differently, but all to serve the same Lord. The Gospel (John 2: 1-11), mentions of Jesus transforming water into wine at a wedding in Cana, revealing Jesus' glory and inspiring his disciples to believe in him. There are many things in this world and in our spiritual lives that need to be transformed. Jesus' power is available to us too. Let us as we listen to God's word reflect on what needs to be transformed/ changed.

#### **SPECIAL JANUARY OBSERVENCES**

January invite us to three special observances: (1) A week of Prayer for Christian Unity (January 18-25). Jesus prays in John 17 that all may be one. This prayer is not yet fully realized. Let us in those days pray for and work for the Christian Unity that Jesus desires for us. (2) January 17th – Martin Luther King, Jr. Holiday. This holiday invites us to avoid any tendency towards discrimination and pray for peace and harmony in our nation. (3) January 22nd – A day of prayer for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children. We are invited to join thousands of Catholics in our diocese and nationwide to pray and participate in events aimed at protecting the gift of human life, at every stage and in every circumstance.


