

Third Sunday in Ordinary Time

We gather together today to worship the Lord, as faithful people have done throughout history. Two noteworthy examples are described in our readings. In the first reading Nehemiah 8: 2-4 when Ezra the priest read the Torah in the streets of Jerusalem after the Jewish people had returned from exile, it brought people to tears. Why? Perhaps they were overwhelmed for being to be together and worship again in their temple, or perhaps it was a remorse for their sins, or perhaps they had been so much touched by the word of God that was read to them. When Jesus (Luke 1: 1-4; 4:14-21) guoted prophet Isaiah, "the Spirit of the Lord is upon me..." to bring glad tidings to the poor, liberty to the captives, sight to the blind and freedom to the oppressed; the eyes of all who were in the synagogue looked intently at him. Today as members of the Body of Christ, we are called in the world to be Christians-Christ like, through our words and actions. St. Paul in the second reading (I Corinthians 12: 12-30) teaches us that we are called to be parts of Christ's body. Individually we are many parts, but together we are one. Let us discover what we can do individually for each other, for our Church and for our communities in the fulfillment of Jesus' mission to bring the good news.

SPECIAL JANUARY OBSERVENCES

In the remaining days of January invite us to: (1) A pray for Christian Unity (January 18-25). Jesus prays in John 17 that all may be one. This prayer is not yet fully realized. Let us in these days pray for and work for the Christian Unity that Jesus desires for us. (2) To pray for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children. We are invited to join thousands of Catholics in our diocese and nationwide to pray and participate in events aimed at protecting the gift of human life, at every stage and in every circumstance.
