

SVDP SOCIETY UPDATE

Burdens which seem overwhelming

Just before Christmas a mother of 5 called us for help with a sewer bill that had built up over the year. She was unaware of the bill until she received a water disconnect notice from GPSD. She did not have a written lease agreement and her landlord failed to tell her she was responsible for it. Sewer bills are sent to the property owner and he was not sending the bills to her.

While this raised the ire in us, we were impressed by the calm demeanor of the woman, her quick response to the situation and her willingness to take responsibility. She called GPSD right away and they explained her option was to pay the bill or fight with the landlord. She told us she didn't want to move or sour the relationship with the landlord. She called 2-1-1, the United Way hotline to community services, and was directed to us and Redeemer Lutheran. We partnered and covered what was needed to keep the water on. She would be able to cover the rest of the bill that was due a few weeks later.

When we met with her, she said she would have budgeted in the \$60 per month sewer bill if she had known it was there. She was on top of her other bills and relied on public transit. We learned that she has been working for the same fast food restaurant for 6 years. We don't usually see that kind of employment stability. She had recently missed work however due to Covid. First her oldest had it in November and she had to test negative to return to work, then her 2 year old had it in December and was forced to quarantine for 2 weeks. She was a month behind on rent and the landlord was being patient. We gave her the website where she could apply for Covid rental assistance from the state.

We asked her if she was receiving the child tax credit. She said she did receive it for 3 months and then it stopped. When she contacted the IRS, she was simply told that it would be included in her tax return in the spring. We have heard this from other families too; the payments have been inconsistent. They will end entirely in January for everyone. We shared information on agencies that have provided free tax filing assistance in the past.

As always, thank you for your generous financial support. This woman was very grateful. Despite her best efforts to work and manage her budget, there were things out of her control, putting her family at risk. Please keep her and all the people we serve in your prayers.

Recognizing God in Ordinary Moments

I Hope I Am Like Him

“Who is this Christ? Is he like you?”

Perhaps you've heard this story, often attributed to the life of St. Teresa of Calcutta. A sick man asked her this question, as he marveled at her tireless service to himself and others in the name of someone named Jesus Christ.

“He is nothing like me,” the saint is said to have answered. “But I hope I am like him.”

Though the authenticity of this exchange cannot be verified, its message rings perfectly true: all the value of our stewardship lies in its relativity to the one in whose name we perform it.

Consider the figure of John the Baptist — a magnificent, towering character even purely from a literary or historical perspective. A martyr who fed on wild locusts and boldly spoke truth to power — a man so great some mistook him for the Messiah.

But why is he great? Because he prepared the way. All his accomplishments and escapades mean nothing if they are taken out of the context of salvation history. He only makes sense relative to Christ — and this is exactly as he wanted it. “One worthier than I is coming,” he insists. And because of that humility and that total embrace of God's will, he is given one of the greatest honors in the New Testament — he baptizes the Son of God.

Let's examine our lives in the light of their relativity to Christ. How do we prepare the way? When Christ comes to us, what do we do? How do we leave ourselves open to be actors in God's plan?
