RENOVATION REPORT

Your weekly update on the progress of the renovation at St. Mary of the Immaculate Conception.



New Brick Exterior

The large scaffolding that we see around the exterior of the building provides support for the crew members that are working on the finishing exterior touches of the addition on the east side. While the iconic yellow Portage brick is no longer in production, a similar product is being used to meld the existing structure to the new structure. Crews have already completed the lower half of the exterior on the north side and will continue until the entire side is completed. A quick drive by the site will also show that they are preparing to begin the work on the south exterior that faces W. Cook St.



Entering the Worship Space

The image below may seem odd without any context, but this wall skeleton provides distinction between the Gathering Space and the Worship Space. The archway above is a common feature that has been used throughout the design of the addition and merges the architectural style of the existing church to the new structure. This threshold will feature a new set of doors that will be edged with baseboard made from the old pews. It certainly does provide some great insight into the great things that will be coming our way!



Lower Level Framing

Much like the upper level of the addition, the lower level is seeing some great progress. Aside from new utilities being installed, this space is also starting to become more defined with the placement of the new wall studs. These steel studs are beginning to separate out the designated spaces below. In addition to framing, some of the walls are already starting to see utility integration and drywall. The image on the left shows the dark outline for the new walls and the image on the right shows the new utility room in the addition.
