
# RENOVATION REPORT

Your weekly update on the progress of the renovation at St. Mary of the Immaculate Conception.



### **Utilities Get More Complex**

It seems as though every time someone walks onto the St. Mary Renovation site, the structure just becomes busier and busier. A lot has been happening on site, but one has to look closely just to see how much. In these past days and weeks, the crew has been moving beyond the structural component of the project to more detail-oriented and specific parts. Most notably, work continues to move forward as the crew runs electrical conduits, plumbing, and HVAC throughout the entire site. Crews have done everything from run new fire-prevention systems to wrapping ductwork and have even installed electrical boxes in all of the designated places!





# **Addition Framing Nears Completion**

The past week saw another massive milestone for the renovation project at St. Mary of the Immaculate Conception as crews drew closer to finishing up the interior framing for the addition. Much of the Lower-Level space has been framed for weeks, allowing the crew to move forward with utility work in that area. With the drywalling of the Upper-Level ceiling complete, crews could finally begin installing the steel studs which are already starting to divide up the space. This particular image shows the framing in the northern section of the addition, which will be home to a new Vesting Sacristy for the Priest, Deacons, and Altar Servers, as well as new male, female and family restrooms. While this area will be closed in, the southern area will remain mostly open to allow much-needed natural light to fill the new Gathering Space.

## **Work Moves On in Sanctuary Space**

The image on the right is a sign of hope for the congregation at St. Mary of the Immaculate Conception. While many things have changed onsite, the one thing that hasn't is the feeling of our Worship Space. The iconic dark timbers and the natural brick are still highlights of this space and will be the foundation for the work that will happen here in the coming weeks. With the space cleared of all obstructions, the crew can begin work on transforming this blank canvas into a beautiful masterpiece, which we will combine the feeling of a new and inviting space with the legacy and countless generations of years past.


