April 17, 2022—Easter Sunday

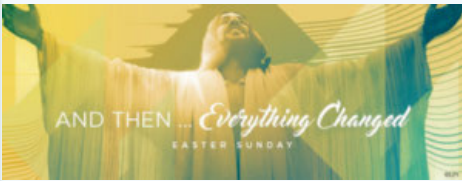
Acts 10:34a, 37-43; Psalms 118:1-2, 16-17, 22-23; Colossians 3:1-4 or 1 Corinthians 5:6B-8; John 20:1-9

First Reading: We hear in the reading from Acts some of the earliest proclamations from Peter about his witness to the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus. To whom in your life should you bear witness to the resurrected Christ?

Second Reading: Using the image of unleavened bread, Paul urges the believers in Corinth to see the resurrection of Jesus as an opportunity to start anew. What needs renewal in your life?

Gospel Reading: The apostles did not initially believe the witness of Mary Magdalene and the other women to news of the resurrection of Jesus. Why do you think so many people today still doubt this good news?

IMPORTANT TAX NOTICE:

Under the revised tax law, many retired people will not be itemizing deductions because the standard deduction has been raised to \$13600 for singles 65 and older (married couples have a standard deduction of \$26600). This means most people will not get a financial benefit from charitable donations. However, by tapping into IRAs to transfer money to charities, retired people are able to lower their taxable income without itemizing. These transfers are called Qualified Charitable Distributions or QCD. IRA owners 70 ½ years and older can transfer up to \$100,000 per year to a qualified charity. Please keep St. Patrick's Parish in mind for this method of giving. Talk to your financial advisor about details.

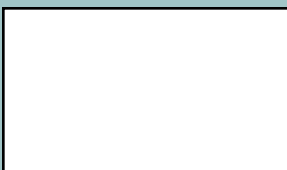
