1st SUNDAY OF LENT

PARTICIPATING IN THE MASS

At Mass, there is a leader. Christ is the High Priest who offers the Sacrifice of Himself to the Father. He offers the very same sacrifice that He offered on Calvary. To use the liturgical language, our Mass today, is “a perpetuation of the Sacrifice of Christ on Calvary.” The Mass we celebrate makes us share in that Sacrifice that Christ offered once and for all.

The priest stands in the place of Christ the head (of the body) to offer the Sacrifice. He is an ALTER CHRISTUS.

After the presentation of the bread and wine (offertory), well aware of his limitations, the priest calls upon the gathered assembly to pray, that “his and their sacrifice” may be acceptable to God the Father. As he does this, he stresses: “my sacrifice and yours” – to stress the communal nature of the Mass.

The prayer is clear: “My sacrifice and yours.”

- The Mass is the Sacrifice of Christ
- The priest offers himself (through Christ) to the Father
- The people (gathered assembly) offer themselves as well (through Christ) to the Father
- The assembly acknowledges the role of the priest as mediator (“sacrifice at your hands”)
- The assembly pleads that the Lord may accept the sacrifice “for the praise and glory of his name” – so, first the Sacrifice is to give praise and glory to the name of the Lord; the Sacrifice is for our good because it is meant really to benefit us since Christ offered Himself for our (we here present at this material time and in this place now) Salvation
- And finally, the Sacrifice is meant for the good of the whole Church – both living and dead

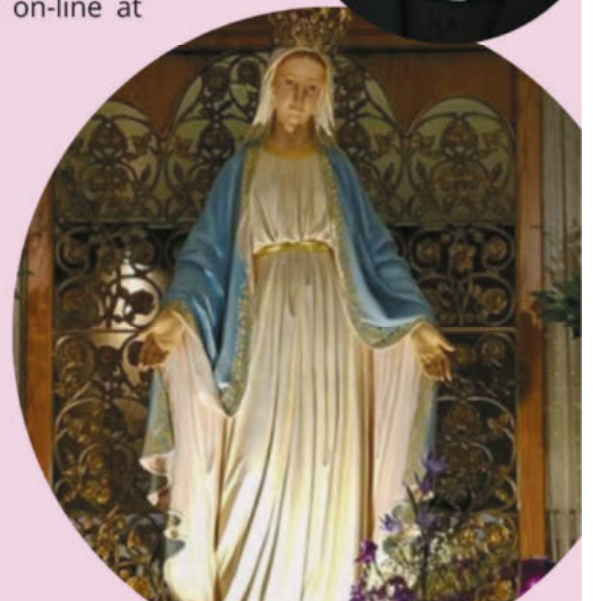
