## 2<sup>nd</sup> SUNDAY OF LENT


**Luke 9:28-36** – The first part of the Gospel deals with the Transfiguration of Jesus which actually takes place while the Apostles are sleeping and Jesus speaks with Moses and Elijah. The second part is when the apostles are awake and join in the conversation. Moses and Elijah are to remind us of the Law and the prophets and their announcements which now find their fulfillment in Jesus Christ.

Peter's experience of the transfiguration is so unique that he wants to remain in that place and environment. While still in awe and wonder, the apostles and Jesus were covered with a cloud (theophanic expression) and then a voice was heard saying "This is my beloved Son" and so revealing the divine identity of Jesus.

Jesus went to the high mountain with three of his disciples: the inner circle of the apostolic group of Jesus. Peter (who would be chosen to lead the church after Jesus went to heaven), James (who would be the first of the Apostles to lay down his life among the apostles, and the first bishop of Jerusalem) and John (who was the ONLY APOSTLE WHO WAS ON CALVARY, one of the three apostles to witness the transfiguration, the last apostle do die, and the only one of the apostles who was not killed). On witnessing the Transfiguration of Jesus, the apostles (through) Peter said "It is wonderful to be here." The apostles wanted to remain in that place, constantly experiencing Christ's divinity, hence his suggestion to build three tents. In the Old Testament, high mountains we considered places where God's presence was experienced in unique ways. They were places for people to go and encounter their gods. The presence of the cloud (especially in the Old Testament) was usually seen as a presence of God. It was from that cloud that the Father's voice was heard: "This is my beloved Son…"

The voice manifests Jesus as God's Son, and it also commands those present to "listen to Him." Who would like to miss God's blessings? Recall the words of the apostle Peter: "It is wonderful to be here," let us today, in our time, build tents of our lives here in God's blessings.


