EASTER SUNDAY

Alleluia, Christ is risen. As we celebrate Easter Sunday, we recall the words of St. Augustine, and we make them our own: "Sing Alleluia, not only with your lips, but with your life." This means that our way of living should also "rise with Christ." We have to live a new life, a life of the resurrection.

As Jesus told the women, He now tells us today "Do not be afraid, go and tell my brothers...," (Matthew 28:10), in other words, Jesus commands us to go and proclaim the resurrection to the others and to the world with our lives.

DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY: THE SUNDAY AFTER EASTER

According to the records, the third longest ruling pope was **Blessed John Paul II**. He was pope from **1978–2005**: **26 years, 5 months and 18 days** (9,665 days). <u>Saint Peter</u> is the longest reigning pope. He ruled the church for 36 years (**AD 29** – **64?** /67?), but the exact length is not reliably known. Then, the second longest was <u>Pope Pius IX</u> (**1846–1878**): **31 years, 7 months and 23 days** (11,560 days). The <u>Shortest-reigning pope</u> was <u>Urban VII</u> (**15–27 September 1590**): reigned for 13 calendar days, and died before his coronation.

During his pontificate, John Paul II visited ALL the continents on the globe, making 104 trips outside Italy. John Paul II canonized more saints than all other popes combined. He established the Luminous Mysteries of the rosary and in 2000 officially established the Sunday following Easter to be the **DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY**. He was a great devotee and promoter of the rosary and devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary.

To observe the Feast of Divine Mercy Sunday, we should do the following: (1) Celebrate the Feast on the Sunday after Easter; (2) Sincerely repent of all our sins; (3) Place our complete trust in Jesus; (4) Go to Confession, preferably before that Sunday (if not possible, then on the very day or following days); (5) Receive Holy Communion on the Feast day; (6) Venerate the image of Jesus of Divine Mercy (that is to make some gesture of a deep religious respect) of the Divine Mercy; and (7) Be merciful to others. In addition to these seven points, then to pray for the intentions of the pope by saying the Creed, Our Father, Hail Mary and Glory be...

Doing the above, one obtains an indulgence for oneself, or for others that you may intend to be beneficiaries of this, or for the souls in Purgatory. **An indulgence** is the remission in the eyes of God, of the temporal punishment due to sins whose culpable element has already been taken away. In order to obtain the indulgence, the person MUST be in a state of grace at least at the time the prescribed works are completed.






