3rd SUNDAY OF EASTER

Acts 5:27-32, 40b-41 – All of today’s three readings attempt to define power. In the first reading, Peter and John are interrogated by the High Priest and the Sanhedrin. The two are in court courageously defending the resurrection of Jesus and its effects. Their answer is that they have to obey God, the God “of our Fathers.” They preach that Jesus is leader and savior: elements that recall the role of Moses. Peter states that forgiveness and change of heart will be granted through His name.

Finally, the apostles are ordered not to preach again, and then they are set free. But their reaction to this restriction is that they rejoice in having had to suffer in the name of Jesus.

Rev. 5:11-14 – John’s vision of the heavenly throne of God. God sits on the throne but the Lamb is not sitting. John hears voices of angels worshipping the Lamb that was once slain but stands near the throne. Then there are four creatures. Here John does not tell us what kind of creatures they were. But recall the vision of Ezekiel 1:4-13 (the Lion-Matthew; the ox-Luke; a man-Mark; the eagle-John). These creatures had the likeness of those in Ezekiel. Then there are the twenty-four elders, but we are not told who they were. Some have interpreted them to be the twelve tribes and the twelve apostles; others think that they are the twenty-four priestly or Levitical orders. None of these is certain.

John 21:1-19 – The gospel opens with Jesus revealing Himself – How? In the way that John narrates. John narrates the miraculous catch of fish: 153 of them. Scholars tell us that at the time, the different types of fishes known in the world were 153; so, this would mean that the apostles were able to catch each kind of fish known at that time, an element that alludes to the universality of the Church. Peter recognizes Jesus through the big catch of fish that had been made and exclaims: “It is the Lord.” Then Peter and his companions are invited to have something to eat. They find fish ready for their breakfast. Note that while Jesus gives them food, He does not eat with them: Overtones of the Eucharist? Peter is asked three times whether he loves Jesus and to each question he answers positively. Here we recall the three times that Peter denied Jesus (Mark 14:29-30; Matthew 26:33-35), at night, near the fire (John 18:18). Now again it is near the fire, Peter affirms three times that he loves Jesus. Then Jesus entrusts the church to him.

THEMES (1) Apostles are witness of the resurrection. (2) Service in leadership – Peter is commissioned to be Shepherd of the followers of Jesus. (3) The Apostles both preach and bear witness to the resurrection of Jesus. (4) Martyrdom – The Apostles bore witness to Christ through their suffering.

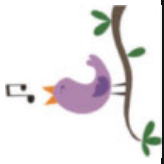
