Acts 14-21-27 – With the resurrection of Jesus from the dead, the triumph of God is revealed more clearly. That is what is apparently meant with the words of Jesus in the Gospel, "Now is the Son of Man glorified." All our readings this weekend attest to this reality.

In the first reading, we hear about Paul and Barnabas' ministry. After Paul and Barnabas were sent away from Antioch, they went to Iconium, Lystra and then to Derbe. From Derbe, they returned through the same cities. In all these cities, they

went preaching the word of God. The reading shows how God's triumph is already among us, though it is still awaited to be complete. Therefore, we may speak of the already but not yet (fully). Paul and Barnabas are itinerant evangelizers. They teach us that suffering and ministry are inseparable. Success in mission depends on God's grace and not our human efforts only. The end of Paul's journey is recounted. Paul is happy that his mission had some fruits even though there were also some hardships. It was a success (v 21). Paul attributes the success to God and not to himself – God's triumph!

Revelation 21:1-5 – John, now in his old age, had a vision and then heard a voice from the throne explaining what the vision meant. The vision started and ended with the theme of "newness". The central point of the vision is cyclic: God dwells with His people." What begins with the new heaven and reaches a climax with God dwelling with his people has the center as 'God dwelling in the city with His people.'

The reality that will come in the age of fulfillment: The writer uses a cyclic way to express his idea, putting the main point at the center. First, we have the new heaven and new earth (**Is 65:17 and 66:22**). Then, we have the former heaven and earth which have gone; the sea (symbol of chaos) is no more. Next, the city descends as a bride, and God dwells in the city with his people. Death is no more. The former things are now no more. Finally, God makes all things new and dwells among his people.

John 13:31-33a, 34-35 – The hour of Eschatological fulfillment is NOW! Judas' leaving sets the preparation for the betrayal, arrest, trial and execution of Jesus. (1) Jesus calls the remaining Apostles "My children" (see Prov. 1:8; 1-15; 2-1), which is used for preparing people for a teaching; (2) Then He gives them the new command to love as Jesus loves: To love your neighbor as you love yourself with a self-sacrificing love. The apostles were expected (as we are also expected) to love Jesus as He loved them, but unfortunately at the moment of trial, they all fled except for Peter and John.

Now, at this moment, it is clear that the Hour of Jesus – the Eschatological Hour – had come. What comes to our minds at this moment is the suffering and death of Jesus, and yet, this is the very moment of Jesus' glorification and triumph. You cannot separate suffering and the cross of Jesus from His triumphant resurrection. What appeared to be the defeat of Jesus actually was His triumph, and He drew all to Himself.

THEMES: (1) A new commandment – which also includes "loving your enemy". (2) A new heaven and a new earth – the age of recreation. (3) A new depth of 'Communion' – God dwells in the midst of his city, the Church. (4) A new manifestation of God's glory – the Hour of Jesus is the Hour of glory!


