Acts 15:1-2, 22-29 – Before our reading, Paul and Barnabas had just returned from their first Missionary journey. They had not had much success in bringing the Jews to the faith, but they had been quite successful on the side of the Gentiles. Our reading begins when the Jewish Christians have sent delegates to Jerusalem (Mother Church of that time) for consultation. Delegates came claiming that Paul and Barnabas were wrong, for they had thought that for one to become a Christian one had first to be circumcised.

When they arrived in Jerusalem, Paul and Barnabas recounted the adventures of their first journey; Peter recalled the Cornelius experience; and James pointed out that in the Old Testament the prophets had foretold of the Gentiles' conversion. The church in Jerusalem had prominence over the others. After the meeting in Jerusalem, it was resolved that the Gentiles had to observe the following: (1) abstain from meat offered to idols; (2) abstain from the meat of strangled animals; (3) and they had to avoid marriages between relatives.

Rev 21:10-14, 22-23 – John's vision of the Holy city of Jerusalem, also referred to as a High Mountain, which is a symbol of God's divine dwelling place. The city coming down is symbolic of God's divine presence. There are two features given about this city: (1) there are gates in its high walls, and (2) the foundation stones. The book of Revelation is full of numbers and symbolisms. For example, 12=the apostles and the twelve tribes. Twelve suggests fullness. 4=Cardinal virtues, the four points of the Earth: Number suggests totality. The visionary seems to be surprised that in the city there is no temple. But in fact, for the Christians, worshipping God is done in and through Christ! Therefore, Christ is the "New Temple." Temple is symbolism of fulfilment in God and the Lamb.

John 14:23-29 - The gospel speaks of a near future of Jesus' departure and then the distant future when the Father and the Son will come to make their permanent dwelling with followers. Other themes in the reading include: (1) There is a link between love and obedience; (2) The partial presentation of a universal relationship in the Trinity; (3) presence of God with the one he loves; (4) God's presence in the one he loves; and finally, (5) Jesus' farewell wish for peace. The love that Jesus teaches in this Gospel is not simply emotional love, it is a self-sacrificing love, a "state of being", a disposition that one lives. Those who do not accept Jesus' word reject both Jesus and the one who sent Him – the Father. But those who accept Jesus' word, also accept Jesus and the Father; and Jesus and the Father will come and make their home in them. Like Jesus, the Holy Spirit is also sent by the Father, but in the name of Jesus.

THEMES (1) The New Jerusalem is built on the foundation of the Apostles, but the gates are inscribed with the names of the tribes of Israel. (2) We have to believe in God and the one whom he has sent. Let us recall to mind the words of Pope John XXIII: "Let there be true unity in what is necessary, freedom in what is doubtful, and charity (love) in everything: We need faith in Jesus". (3) Christ's peace – Jesus wished His people to have peace. This was Jesus' last gift to His people.




