The Baptism of the Lord

Traditionally as the Church commemorates Jesus' baptism in the Jordan River by his cousin, John the Baptist, the Popes have celebrated Mass on this feast in the Sistine Chapel baptizing around 30 babies. Last year, Pope Francis encouraged the families who were there with their babies for baptism that "...in baptism we give him or her a treasure, we give them a pledge: The Holy Spirit. It is important to baptize children, so that they grow up with the power of the Holy Spirit." He also encouraged the families to raise their children by nurturing this gift of the Holy Spirit in them through catechesis, teaching, and a lived-out example in their homes.

Due to the pandemic, Deacon Jerome and I have moved to "private" and single-family baptisms, but really baptisms are meant for the community, because the child becomes a new member of our family of faith. Last year in 2021, we celebrated 62 baptisms! About 16 of these were celebrated in Spanish. With the addition of Dcn. Jerome to our Parish, we now have another ordained minister who can preside at the Sacrament of Baptism. Dcn. Jerome also is coordinating our Baptismal Ministry, and you may contact him if you would like to baptize your child.

Children are always welcome at our Masses, and it is okay if they cry. When a child cries in church, it's a beautiful homily!



El Bautismo del Señor

Tradicionalmente, cuando la Iglesia conmemora el bautismo de Jesús en el río Jordán por su primo, Juan el Bautista, los Papas han celebrado la Misa en esta fiesta en la Capilla Sixtina bautizando a alrededor de 30 bebés. El año pasado, el Papa Francisco alentó a las familias que estaban allí con sus bebés para el bautismo que "... en el Bautismo le damos un tesoro, le damos una promesa: El Espíritu Santo. Es importante bautizar a los niños, para que crezcan con el poder del Espíritu Santo". También alentó a las familias a criar a sus hijos nutriendo este don del Espíritu Santo en ellos a través de la catequesis, la enseñanza y un ejemplo vivido en sus hogares.

Debido a la pandemia, el diácono Jerome y yo hemos pasado a hacer bautismos "privados" y unifamiliares, pero realmente los bautismos están destinados a la comunidad, porque el niño se convierte en un nuevo miembro de nuestra familia de fe. El año pasado en 2021, celebramos 62 bautismos! Alrededor de 16 de estos se celebraron en español. Con la adición del diácono Jerome a nuestra Parroquia, ahora tenemos otro ministro ordenado que puede presidir el Sacramento del Bautismo. El diácono Jerome también está coordinando nuestro Ministerio Bautismal y puede comunicarse con él si desea bautizar a su hijo.

Los niños siempre son bienvenidos en nuestras Misas y no pasa nada si lloran. Cuando un niño llora en la iglesia, ¡es una hermosa homilía!

By working together and making the best of our situation, you made this Christmas special for our parish family and I will forever be grateful for you!

Gospel Reflection/Reflexión del Evangelio

Lk 3:15-16,21-22

By this time, many people will have taken down Christmas decorations, holiday traveling will mostly be completed and children will be heading back to school. The excitement, the hubbub, the get-togethers of the holiday season are over, and we are faced with long weeks of winter. In Wisconsin. In the cold. So, it is about this time of year when we begin to hear stories about “polar plunges” – those events, sometimes for charity, in which people leap into an icy lake, throwing themselves bodily beneath the water to emerge sputtering and very much awake!

Today we celebrate the Baptism of the Lord, and it is a good time to reflect on our own baptism. The word “baptism” comes to us from a Greek word meaning “to immerse.” Spiritually, baptism should be like those polar plunges, in which we leap fully into the life of Christ, to be fully awakened in our faith. And baptism plunges us into that life not just on the day of our baptism, but every day of our lives after that. It can be difficult this time of year after all the activity of the Christmas season to throw ourselves into anything, but we are called by the same Spirit that descended upon Jesus to renew our baptism each day as a member of Christ’s body on earth. So, let’s take a few minutes today to think about the ways in which we can immerse ourselves in Christ. Then let’s go take the plunge!



Lc 3:15-16,21-22

Para esta fecha, muchas personas habrán retirado las decoraciones navideñas, los viajes navideños se completarán en su mayoría y los niños regresarán a la escuela. La emoción, el bullicio, las reuniones de la temporada navideña han terminado y nos enfrentamos a largas semanas de invierno. En Wisconsin. En el frío. Por lo tanto, es en esta época del año cuando comenzamos a escuchar historias sobre “zambullidas polares”, esos eventos, a veces por caridad, en los que las personas saltan a un lago helado, arrojándose corporalmente debajo del agua para emerger chisporroteando y muy despiertas.

Hoy celebramos el bautismo del Señor, y es un buen momento para reflexionar sobre nuestro propio bautismo. La palabra “bautismo” viene a nosotros de una palabra griega que significa “sumergirse”. Espiritualmente, el bautismo debe ser como esas zambullidas polares, en las que saltamos plenamente a la vida de Cristo, para despertar plenamente en nuestra fe. Y el bautismo nos sumerge en esa vida no sólo el día de nuestro bautismo, sino todos los días de nuestras vidas después de eso. Puede ser difícil en esta época del año después de toda la actividad de la temporada navideña lanzarnos a cualquier cosa, pero somos llamados por el mismo Espíritu que descendió sobre Jesús para renovar nuestro bautismo cada día como miembro del cuerpo de Cristo en la tierra. Entonces, tomemos unos minutos hoy para pensar en las formas en que podemos sumergirnos en Cristo, ¡y a dar la zambullida!

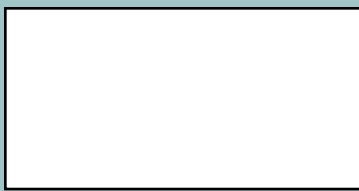
