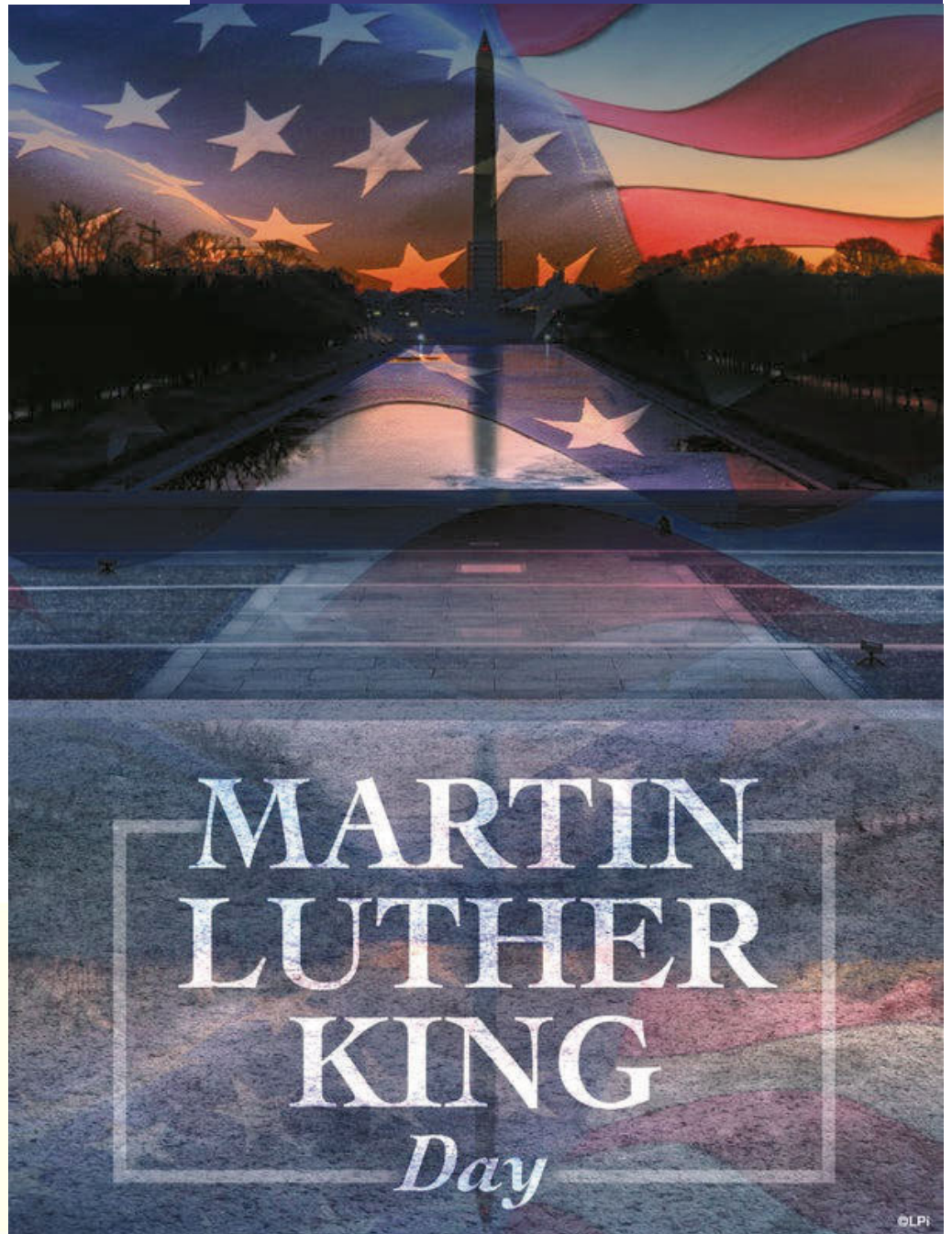

Second Sunday of Ordinary Time

Today's Gospel (John 2:1-11) tells of Jesus' first miracle, turning the water into wine at the Wedding Feast in Cana. This is a marvelous episode of Jesus' life where we see the strong role Mary plays in Jesus' life and His saving mission. Even Jesus obeys His mother when she asks Jesus to help the couple who ran out of wine at their wedding reception. St. John fittingly calls Jesus' miracles "signs" because by them, Jesus reveals God the Father's merciful love. The fact that the first miracle or sign takes place in the context of a wedding, is a sign to us of a new and deeper covenant that Jesus came to establish between humankind and God. The miracle at Cana reminds us that we are invited, as members of the Lord's family, the Church, to draw near to him in faith, and thus to share in the joy of the wedding feast of the new and eternal covenant.

Gospel Reflection/Reflexión del Evangelio

Jn 2:1-11

Today, a bit of a “mash-up” article – New Year’s resolutions, one line from the Gospel, our second reading and a line from the Responsorial Psalm.

Beginning the new year is the time for making resolutions. In many ways, today’s readings are a little nudge to us as an evangelizing parish to make some resolutions for the coming year. In our Gospel today, Mary says to the servers about Jesus, “Do whatever he tells you.” We, too, must recognize that we are servers for the Lord, and do what he tells us. One way he tells us things is by giving us each unique gifts and talents to use in spreading his Word. In our second reading from Corinthians today, Paul lists some of these gifts of the Spirit that we are to employ in God’s service, though there are many others. So, our resolutions for our new year should be – What gifts has God given to me? How am I using those talents in His service? How can I better employ those gifts for the good of the Kingdom? By using the generous gifts God has given us in the service of evangelization, we will (as our psalmists tell us) truly be able to “proclaim his marvelous deeds to all the nations.”

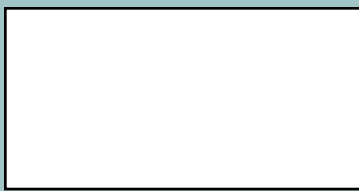
