Fourth Sunday of Ordinary Time Happy Parish Feast Day (January 28)!

This weekend we have substituted the regular Sunday Readings for the Fourth Sunday of Ordinary Time with the Readings from the Memorial Mass of St. Thomas Aquinas. The theme of our Gospel (Mathew 23: 8-12) is about having one teacher and master, who is Jesus Christ. This is a good time as a parish family to reflect upon how we are growing in our knowledge of our faith and continuing to be lifelong learners. We have a beautiful faith! There is so much joy and beauty in the beliefs and teachings of the Catholic Church. G.K. Chesterton once wrote, “The difficulty in explaining ‘why I am a Catholic’ is that there are ten thousand reasons all amounting to one reason: that Catholicism is true.” The Catholic Church is not just one denomination among many. In fact, it can trace its founding roots back to Jesus Christ, who started our Church. For 2,000 years, the Catholic Church has guarded the truth that Jesus has taught, whether in or out of style. In the Church today, one can experience the most personal relationship with Christ through the Holy Eucharist, the gift of Christ’s Body and Blood to us. Since its founding, the Catholic Church has continued to be the largest body of Christians on earth. Though it’s not perfect, nor does it have perfect members, the Church still contains the fullness of truth, which Jesus promised would set us free. As the Blessed Archbishop Fulton Sheen (Beatified Dec. 21, 2019) once said, “There are not even 100 people in this country who hate the Catholic Church, but there are millions who hate what they think the Catholic Church to be.” The word “Catholic” means universal, and that is really what the Catholic Church is—a universal body of believers, united in Jesus Christ, our Lord and Savior. Our Catholic family is made up of people of every race, age, and walk of life. For centuries, the Catholic Church has been the place to turn to for the source of Christian belief, an intimate encounter with Jesus Christ, a welcoming family, and a guiding light to get to heaven.

We have a strong patron Saint in Thomas Aquinas to inspire us to devote our lives to Jesus Christ. We have a special gift of one another who make up this unique loving family of disciples. Catholic author Mathew Kelly points out:

“The people we surround ourselves with either raise or lower our standards. They either help us to become the best-version-of-ourselves or encourage us to become lesser versions of ourselves. We become like our friends. No man becomes great on his own. No woman

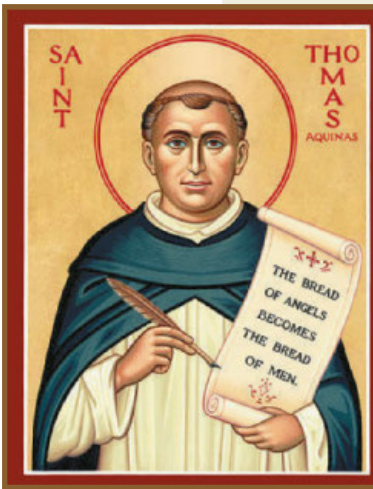

About our Patron, St. Thomas Aquinas

Philosopher and theologian, St. Thomas Aquinas, was born circa 1225 in Roccasecca, Italy. Combining the theological principles of faith with the philosophical principles of reason, he ranked among the most influential thinkers of medieval Scholasticism. An authority of the Roman Catholic Church and a prolific writer, Aquinas died on March 7, 1274, at the Cistercian monastery of Fossanova, near Terracina, Latium, Papal States, Italy.

St. Thomas Aquinas was a great theologian, philosopher and Doctor of the Church. A Dominican Priest from Italy, Saint Thomas Aquinas is the Patron Saint of Catholic universities, colleges and schools. St. Thomas Aquinas is credited with composing more than 60 literary works during his lifetime. Perhaps his most well-known piece of work is “Summa Theologica”, a piece St. Thomas Aquinas wrote as a manual of Christian doctrine for students. His Feast Day is January 28.

Nuestro Patrón, Santo Tomas de Aquino

Filósofo y teólogo Santo Tomas Aquino nació 1225 en Roccasecca, Italia. Combinando los principios teológicos de fe con los principios filosóficos de la razón, santo tomas ranquea entre los pensadores más influenciadores de la escolástica medieval. Una autoridad de la iglesia católica romana y un prolífico escritor, Aquino murió el 7 de marzo de 1274 en el monasterio cisterciense de Fossanova, cerca de Terracina, Latium, estados papales, Italia.

San Tomas de Aquino fue un gran teólogo, filosofo y doctor de la iglesia. Un sacerdote dominicano de Italia. San Tomas Aquino es el santo patrón de universidades católicas, colegios y escuelas. San Tomas Aquino ha sido acreditado con la composición de mas de 60 trabajos de literatura durante su tiempo de vida. Quizás su trabajo más reconocido es “Summa Theologica”, Santo Tomas escribió esta pieza como manual de la doctrina cristiana para estudiantes. Su Dia de celebración es enero 28.

A Prayer Before Mass (by St. Thomas Aquinas)

Almighty and everlasting God, behold I come to the Sacrament of Thine only-begotten Son, our Lord Jesus Christ: I come as one infirm to the physician of life, as one unclean to the fountain of mercy, as one blind to the light of everlasting brightness, as one poor and needy to the Lord of heaven and earth. Therefore I implore the abundance of Thy measureless bounty that Thou wouldst vouchsafe to heal my infirmity, wash my uncleanness, enlighten my blindness, enrich my poverty and clothe my nakedness, that I may receive the Bread of Angels, the King of kings, the Lord of lords, with such reverence and humility, with such sorrow and devotion, with such purity and faith, with such purpose and intention as may be profitable to my soul's salvation. Grant unto me, I pray, the grace of receiving not only the Sacrament of our Lord's Body and Blood, but also the grace and power of the Sacrament. O most gracious God, grant me so to receive the Body of Thine only-begotten Son, our Lord Jesus Christ, which He took from the Virgin Mary, as to merit to be incorporated into His mystical Body, and to be numbered amongst His members. O most loving Father, give me grace to behold forever Thy beloved Son with His face at last unveiled, whom I now purpose to receive under the sacramental veil here below. Amen.

Gospel Reflection/Reflexión del Evangelio

Of Castles and Oxen

Our reflection today comes from the Gospel for the Memorial of St. Thomas Aquinas (Mt 28:8-12). This passage from Matthew stresses the need to be humble, and we have no better example than St. Thomas Aquinas. Recognized today as one of the greatest philosophers and theologians in Church history, the writer of the famous Summa Theologica (and other works), and called the Angelic Doctor, he wasn't always perceived to be a brilliant thinker. Because of his large size and quiet nature, his fellow students at the university named him the "Dumb Ox." Thomas took the name in stride, and in some ways the appellation is fitting. Oxen are deliberate and persistent, as was Thomas. He was born in a wealthy family, and when he decided on a monastic life, his family hoped he would join the Benedictines and someday become the Abbot of the prestigious abbey at Monte Cassino. Instead, Thomas was drawn to the poverty and love of study of the Dominicans. This did not please his family, who imprisoned him in the family castle for a year while they tried in vain to change his mind. But Thomas was steadfast in his choice. Once he was free, he joined the Dominicans and went to the university, where he plowed through his studies with the same tenacity and determination. But he also recognized that his writings, brilliant though they might be, were nothing compared to the love and mercy of God. Devout in prayer, late in his life, Thomas had a mystical experience, and afterward described his fabulous writings to be nothing but straw as compared to the vision of heaven he had glimpsed. To compare your life's work to straw shows a wonderful humility for us to emulate. But even if he deemed them "straw," Thomas' writings are a treasure for the Church, and I urge you to make yourself acquainted with them in some fashion. As his teacher St. Albert the Great said: "We call him the dumb ox, but one day he will emit such a bellowing in his teaching that it will be heard throughout the world."



De Castillos y Bueyes

Nuestra reflexión hoy viene del evangelio del día conmemorativo de Santo Tomas Aquino (Mt 28:8 -12). Este pasaje de Mateo hace énfasis en la necesidad de ser humilde y no hay mejor ejemplo que el de Santo Tomas Aquino. Reconocido hoy como uno de los más grandes filósofos y teólogos de la historia de la iglesia, el escritor del famoso Summa Theologica (y otros trabajos) y llamado el doctor angelical, no siempre fue percibido como un pensador brillante. Debido a su gran tamaño y naturaleza callada, sus compañeros estudiantes de la universidad lo llamaban el "buey tonto." Tomas de Aquino tomo este nombre, y en algunas formas esta denominación hacia sentido. Bueyes son intencionados y persistentes, como Tomas de Aquino. El nació en una familia de altos recursos, y cuando el tomo la decisión de entrar al monasterio, su familia esperaba que él se uniera a los Benedictinos y algún día se convirtiera en la cabeza del prestigioso Monte Casino. Pero Santo Tomas fue llamado a la pobreza y al amor por el estudio de los dominicanos. Esto no complació a su familia quienes lo encerraron en el castillo de la familia por un año tratando y con la esperanza de cambiar sus ideas, pero Tomas de Aquino fue firme en su elección. Una vez fue liberado, él se unió a los dominicanos y fue a la universidad donde siguió con sus estudios con la misma tenacidad y determinación. Pero él también reconoció que sus escritos, por mas brillantes que fueran, eran nada comparado al amor y misericordia de Dios. Devoto en oración, tarde en su vida, Tomas Aquino tuvo una experiencia mística, y después de esta experiencia mística, el describió sus famosos escritos como siendo nada, como paja, comparándolos con la visión del cielo que él había vivido. Comparar el trabajo de su vida con paja muestra la tremenda humildad que nosotros debemos emular. Pero inclusive si el consideró su trabajo como "paja," sus escritos son un tesoro para la iglesia. Los invito a conocer, estudiar y hacerse familiar con estos escritos de alguna manera. Como su profesor San Alberto el Grande dijo: "Nosotros lo llamamos el buey tonto, pero un día el va a emitir tan grandes gritos en sus enseñanzas que el va a ser escuchado en todo el mundo."

HVAC Controls: Update & Installation

Over the course of the past year, we have been working on updating and replacing our HVAC controls for the church, chapel, gathering space, library, conference rooms, and offices in the church wing of the building. This was not an anticipated expense and was not budgeted as part of the Make Disciples Capital Campaign. The original control system was a pneumatic (air pressure) based control system, which was installed in the brick walls of the church when the church was built. Now that our building is 45+ years old, the lines that carry the air to the thermostats and the controls have begun to fail, and there is no easy way to fix or replace the leaking air lines or the controls themselves.

As Fr. Bart has mentioned, once our system began to fail, this became an immediate concern, and we began this initial phase of updates, which came with a price tag of \$40,000. We reached out to a few different vendors and chose the most competitive bid, along with the company that we trusted to undertake this rather large project. This included running new wires and installing new digital temperature and humidity sensors and thermostats in each of the rooms, replacing all the pneumatic valves with electronically controlled valves, and adding automated controls to the ductwork to control fresh air intake into the building, helping to keep all of us healthy and safe. The new control system monitors and controls the temperature and humidity of the building and provides staff with alerts and notifications on the status of the building through a digital interface, installed on our server.

This update will not only make our spaces more comfortable but will also provide a cost savings to us on our monthly utility bills. While we replaced our boiler with an on-demand system a few years ago, we have not seen as large of a reduction in costs as we had hoped, simply because the heating system itself has not been operating in an efficient manner. Thanks to the generosity of our parishioners and friends, this expense has been covered by your gifts, in response to Fr. Bart's plea for assistance. This new control system should allow us to see more energy savings in the future, as we strive to be good stewards of your gifts and of God's creation.

This new system will also interface with the rest of our parish complex, as we continue our work through the remaining phases of our Make Disciples Capital Campaign. The social hall and kitchen HVAC systems were updated during Phase 2 and will be connected to and integrated with the control system that has been installed in the church and offices. Once we move into Phase 3, then the entire Enrichment Wing (Religious Education) will be updated and integrated as well. We are grateful to all our parishioners and friends who are so generous and support the ministry and mission of Jesus, here at St. Thomas Aquinas!

HVAC Controles: Actualización e instalación

Durante el año pasado hemos trabajado en la actualización y remplazo de los controles de nuestro HVAC para la iglesia, capilla, área social, librería, salas de conferencia, y oficinas en el área de la iglesia del edificio. Esto no fue un gasto que había sido anticipado y no se había incluido en el presupuesto capital de la campaña hacer discípulos. El sistema original de controles era basado en un sistema neumático (presión de aire) que fue instalado en la pared de ladrillos de la iglesia cuando la iglesia fue construida. El edificio ahora tiene 45 años, las líneas que llevan el aire al termostato y controles han empezado a fallar y no hay una forma fácil de arreglar o remplazar las fugas de aire o los mismos controles.

Como lo menciono el padre Bart, cuando el sistema empezó a fallar se convirtió en un problema inmediato y nosotros comenzamos las primeras fases de actualización que costo \$40,000. Contactamos varios proveedores y escogimos la mejor oferta competitiva, y la compañía más confiable capaz de completar este proyecto grande. Este proyecto incluye nuevos cables y la instalación de sensores digitales de temperatura y humedad, termostatos en cada cuarto, remplazo de todas las válvulas neumáticas por válvulas controladas electrónicamente, y la adición de controles automatizados a los conductos para controlar el aire fresco que entra al edificio, todos estos cambios para mantenernos sanos y salvos. El nuevo sistema de control monitorea y controla la temperatura y humedad del edificio y proporciona al personal alertas y notificaciones en el estado del edificio por medio de interfaz digital instalada en nuestro servidor.

Esta actualización no solo hará que los espacios sean más cómodos, pero también ayudan a ahorrar dinero en los recibos de servicios de cada mes. Aunque nosotros reemplazamos la caldera por un sistema de demanda un par de años atrás, no hemos notado una reducción en los costos como nosotros esperábamos, simplemente porque el sistema de calefacción no ha venido siendo operado de una forma eficiente. Gracias a la generosidad de todos los feligreses y amigos, este gasto ha sido cubierto por todas las donaciones en respuesta a las peticiones y suplicas por asistencia del padre Bart. Este nuevo sistema de control nos permitirá tener ahorros en los gastos de energía en el futuro, nosotros nos esforzamos de ser buenos administradores de sus donaciones y de la creación de Dios.

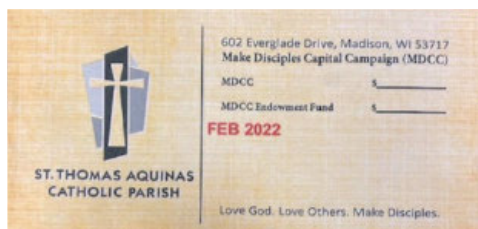
Este sistema nuevo estará conectado con el resto del complejo del edificio, mientras continuamos trabajando en las fases de nuestra campaña capital de hacer discípulos. El HVAC sistema del área social y la cocina fueron actualizados durante la fase 2 y serán conectados e integrados con el sistema de control que ha sido instalado en la iglesia y oficinas. Una vez comencemos con la fase 3, toda el Centro de Enriquecimiento (Educación religiosa) será actualizado e integrado también. ¡Estamos muy agradecidos por todos los feligreses y amigos quienes generosamente han apoyado el ministerio y misión de Jesús aquí en San Tomas Aquino!

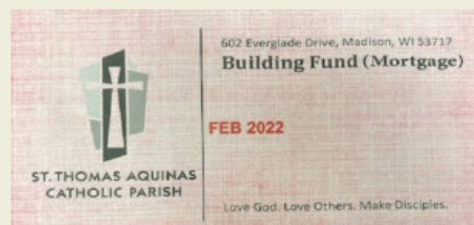

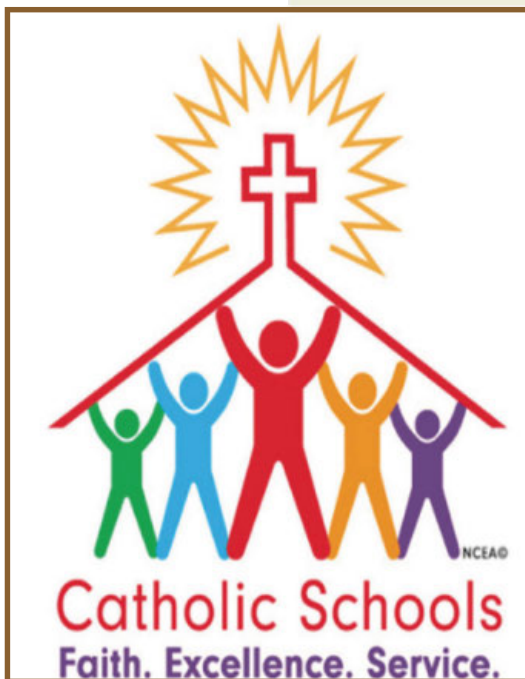

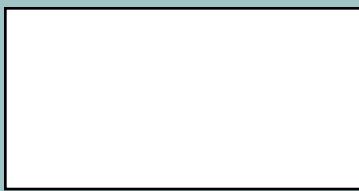
