

Fourth Sunday of Lent

This Sunday, we have the Parable of the loving Father and the Prodigal Son to reflect upon. The story of the prodigal son shows us something of the mystery of human relations, both in the celebration for the son who was lost, but also in the feeling of betrayal and indignation on the part of

his brother. On the doorstep of that home we see our own divisions and strife. We can relate to this family situation because there are plenty of issues in our families among the members that call for forgiveness. But beyond the problems of family life, we also see in all its radiant clarity, with no ifs and or buts, the father's desire that all his sons and daughters should share in his love and joy. When we have problems in our family between spouses, between spouses and children, between siblings, between in-laws, bring these problems to Jesus in prayer and contemplate the heart of the father in this parable. From this perspective we can acknowledge once more that we are all brothers and sisters.



Gospel Reflection

Lk 15:1-3,11-32

In the Gospel story today of the Prodigal Son, we find the youngest son destitute and starving on a pig farm. In fact, he was so hungry the Gospel says "he longed to eat his fill of the pods on which the swine fed." What struck me in this sentence is the word 'pods;' Pods are just empty shells for food. What the son was longing for initially was just that – material goods, but those proved to be hollow shells. It is only when he realizes it's not hunger for material goods, or even food for survival that he really craves, it is hunger for his Father, that he finds his way out of his dilemma. It is then he makes a sacrifice, by abandoning his ego, by abandoning his attachment to the material and returning to the Father, not primarily for food, but for forgiveness. Food not for the body, but for the soul.

Lent is a perfect time to take stock of our spiritual pantry. Are our Lenten pastries of self-denial stuffed with prayer and charity? When we sacrifice are we just giving up or are we making holy?

When we think about what we gave up for Lent, let's think about why we gave it up and see where that thought takes us. It could very well bring us home to the Father.
