#### Sixth Sunday of Easter

Jesus appears to the Apostles in today's Gospel episode, gives them the gift of peace and promises to send them the Holy Spirit to be their "Advocate." What is the area of your life that is in need of peace? Have you invited the Holy Spirit, by name, to enter this space? How can

you ask the Holy Spirit to address this aspect of your life? Jesus has already given us the Holy Spirit at confirmation. We have this gift. We need to call it forward in a specific way. The Spirit is there waiting to be invited in.

#### Welcome Bishop Hying!

This Sunday we celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation with 42 of our young people at a special 2:00 p.m. Mass. We welcome our bishop, Bishop Donald Hying, who will be here at STA to celebrate this sacrament with us. The presence of our Bishop underscores the importance of Confirmation. The Bishop is the successor of the Apostles upon whom the Holy Spirit descended on Pentecost. As leader, the Bishop signifies our unity in faith. It gives all of us an opportunity to pray with and meet Bishop Hying who is the local leader of our Church.

Confirmation harkens back to the original experience of Pentecost, when the Holy Spirit came down on the infant Church and empowered it to carry on the life and mission of Jesus. Confirmation is a personal Pentecost for our young people and will empower them to carry on the life and mission of Jesus in our lives today. Congratulations to our Confirmandi, to their sponsors, and to their parents on this most monumental occasion!

Thank you to the parents for their commitment to raising their children in the faith. Thank you to Robert Rosa Cruz, our Director of Youth Ministry. Thank you to all who helped with our Confirmation Mass and reception, and for all you do to support the youth of our parish!

#### Ministers of Hospitality and Greeters Needed

Are you a people person? If so, our parish family needs Ministers of Hospitality and Greeters. Greeters stand at the doors to the Church and welcome everyone! You schedule yourself as a greeter. Ministers of Hospitality greet people, help people find a seat, take up the collection, put out bulletins, and have other duties. If you are interested, please contact Holly at holly@stamadison.org.

#### **Rosebud Program**

The Rosebud Program is a way for parents and grandparents to request prayers and support for anyone who is pregnant, celebrating birth or adoption, grieving miscarriage, stillbirth, abortion, infant or child death, or waiting to become pregnant or adopt.

Here is how it works: In the Gathering Area by the statue of Mary, there are a variety of colored roses and cards that address the needs listed above. Each rose represents a special need. The person wanting prayers writes their name on the card matching their prayer request, chooses the appropriate colored rose and then puts it into the vase. The prayers are put onto the prayer chain.

## How wonderful it was to be together for a Spirit-filled Parish Renewal on May 9-11!

Led by Mari Pablo of Evangelical Catholic, our parish family was inspired, given a chance to hone some of our evangelization skills, and then worked together to determine priorities to develop as an evangelizing parish of missionary disciples.

Each night, Spanish-speaking and English-speaking members of our parish started together in prayer and song before breaking into our specific language groups. A favorite song (used all three nights) was the bilingual "Amor de Dios/O Love of God" that speaks of our unity through baptism and asks God to "Make us all one family; bring us together to do the works of love. Haznos una familia que se une por obras de tu amor." You just may hear this one at Mass sometimes, too!





On Monday and Tuesday, Mari was amazing...she did all the talks in both Spanish and English! On Monday, we focused on **remembering our call**. Mari pointed out that Jesus invites all of us to follow Him and to make disciples. We are called through our baptism to joyfully bring others to the Lord. Staff members Holly Irving and Julia Hix lent a hand with an activity that pointed to the importance of having good conversation skills and reflecting on Mt 5:13-16—our call to be salt and light. Staff members Robert Rosa-Cruz and Margarita Cabada led the same activities in Spanish.



Tuesday gave us a chance to **recount God's work.** When we talk about God's work in our own lives, we can point out to others how God works in their lives, too. Directed by staff members Erik Gyr and Deacon Jerome Buhman (in English) and Robert and Margarita (in Spanish), participants shared "mini testimonies" with partners, and a few people were even brave enough to share with the whole assembly! We ended the night with time in Adoration, prayerfully offering the stories of our lives to the Lord.



Finally, on Wednesday, we shifted our focus to **renewing our parish.** We are called to discipleship not only as individuals, but also as a community. Over 130 people came together for a meal in our newly renovated social hall, then prayerfully reflected in small groups about where the Holy Spirit is calling us to focus our energy. Over the next 2-3 years, what would bear the most fruit? Two priorities were clearly discerned – a focus on nurturing our personal relationships with Jesus, on developing greater engagement of young adults, including families with young children. How will this actually look? Stay tuned! The next step will be to develop concrete "SMART" goals (*specific, measurable, achievable, and relevant*). Let us pray for the Holy Spirit to continue to guide us, so that we may **Go, Make Disciples**!



## **Gospel Reflection**

#### John 14:23-29

Both last week's Gospel and our Gospel today give us a little hint of what is coming the next couple weeks, with the Ascension and Pentecost. Last week, Jesus said, "My children, I will be with you only a little while longer," and today he says, "The Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you everything and remind you of all that I told you." In today's Gospel, though Jesus tells his disciples that he will soon no longer be with them physically, he promises that "whoever loves me will keep my Word, and my Father will love him, and we will come to him and make our dwelling with him." Taken together, these are beautiful statements of the promise of the Trinitarian God -- Father, Son and Spirit -- to be with us. In this one brief passage, Jesus assures us of the presence of Himself, the Father and the Spirit in our lives. And more than that, Jesus speaks of God not just being occasionally present, but making His dwelling in us. This promise of God's desire for a close personal relationship with us should fill us with joy, wonder and hope!
