

Parish News and Words from Our Pastor

Noticias Parroquiales y Mensaje de Nuestro Párroco

20th Sunday of Ordinary Time

I have always felt that Jesus' words in this Gospel (Luke 12:49-53) seem at odds with the rest of His message. Establishing division? That doesn't sound like a Christian worldview. However, Jesus is inviting us to recognize the reality of following Him in our world. It will cause division. A follower of Christ, who willingly flips the assumptions and desires of the material world, will inevitably cause division. We are called to "set the world on fire," challenging the self-serving order of civilization and placing love at the center. Inviting people to serve God and others before themselves is an inflammatory suggestion.



Parish Plan for Evangelization- Go Make Disciples!

Since our Parish Renewal in May after Easter, we have been working with parish leaders to identify our path forward for evangelization. First, we set for ourselves two main priorities:

- #1: Nurturing a personal relationship with Jesus
- #2: Developing great engagement of young adults, including families with young children.

Then we established 4 SMART goals, goals that are Specific, Measurable, Achievable, Realistic, and Time bound. These goals are:

1. By April 2024, STA will increase participation in small faith groups by 10% from 211 people to 232 people.
2. According to the DMI Survey, 20% of respondents have attended a retreat. By April, 2024, STA will increase that percentage to 30%
3. By April 2024, STA will have a 100% increase in the number of families registered for faith formation/sacramental preparation, from 145 to 290 households.
4. By April 2024, STA will develop and involve 25% of newly married couples, parents of newly baptized children, newly initiated, or newly registered young adults in follow-up opportunities.

Lastly, we brainstormed strategies and tools that we will employ to reach our goals. We will need all of us to work together, to be on fire with the Holy Spirit and accomplish these goals as we share our faith and love for Jesus with others! Thank you for all you do to support our mission and to help accomplish our goals!

20° Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

Siempre he sentido que las palabras de Jesús en este Evangelio (Lucas 12:49-53) parecen contradecir el resto de Su Mensaje. Establecer división? Esto no suena como una visión mundial Cristiana. Sin embargo, Jesús nos está invitando a reconocer la realidad de seguirlo a Él en nuestro mundo: va a causar división. Un seguidor de Cristo, que voluntariamente se revela en contra de las suposiciones y deseos del mundo material, va a causar inevitablemente división. Estamos llamados a "prender en fuego al mundo entero", desafiando el orden interesado de la civilización y poniendo el amor en el centro. Invitar personas a servir a Dios y a los otros antes que ellos mismos es una sugerencia irritante.

Plan de la Parroquia para Evangelización Ve y Haz Discípulos!

Desde nuestra Renovación Parroquial en mayo después de Pascua, hemos estado trabajando con los líderes de la parroquia para identificar nuestro camino hacia delante para evangelización. Primero, establecimos para nosotros dos prioridades principales:

- #1: Cultivar una Relación Personal con Jesús y
- #2: Desarrollar una mayor participación de los adultos jóvenes, incluyendo familias con niños pequeños.

Luego establecimos 4 metas utilizando el método SMART, metas que son Específicas (Specific), Medibles, Alcanzables, Referentes y Oportunas (Timely). Estas metas son:

1. Para abril 2024, STA aumentara a un 10% la participación de los grupos pequeños de fe, de 211 personas a 232 personas.
2. De acuerdo con la encuesta DMI, 20% de los que respondieron participaron de un retiro. Para abril 2024, STA aumentara ese porcentaje a 30%.
3. Para abril 2024, STA tendrá un aumento de 100% en el número de familias registradas para la formación de fe/preparación sacramental, de 145 a 290 familias.
4. Para abril 2024, STA desarrollará e involucrará 25% de las parejas recién casadas, padres de niños recién bautizados, jóvenes adultos que se hayan iniciado en la fe o registrado recientemente en oportunidades de seguimiento.

Por último, discutimos estrategias y herramientas que utilizaremos para cumplir nuestras metas. Tendremos que trabajar juntos, arder con el Espíritu Santo para alcanzar estas metas a la vez que compartimos nuestra fe y amor por Jesús con otros! Gracias por todo lo que hacen para apoyar nuestra misión y por ayudar a cumplir nuestras metas!

Gospel Reflection

Luke 12:49-53

Jesus says he comes to “set the earth on fire.” When we think about fire, we often consider only its destructive properties that leave only devastation in its wake. However, biblically speaking, fire imagery was often used to describe a refining or purifying process. That process, however, does result in division – the material being refined separates from the dross. Jesus knows that not everyone will accept his message and that it will cause divisions among peoples and even families. Recognizing that his own death is approaching at the hands of those who cannot (or will not) accept his Word, Jesus is telling his followers that living as true Christians will often be uncomfortable, sometimes dangerous, or even deadly. It is a reminder to us that adhering to Jesus’ teachings may put us at odds with others, even those who are close to us.

Maybe that’s not **really** what RCIA stands for, but if you are curious, read on . . .

In general:

Do you have questions about faith?

Are you searching for a safe place to discuss issues and questions regarding God and faith?

Are you searching for something that seems to be missing from your life?

Or specifically:

Have you been a Catholic all your life, but never celebrated all the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation, Eucharist)?

Have you joined us from a different faith background & would like to find out more about the Catholic Church?

Have you been worshiping with us, but never officially taken the step to become Catholic?

Have you been away from the Church, and have now returned, but want to know more?

If you or someone you know answers **YES** to any of these questions, you are invited to find out more through a process called the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA). It is a journey that begins with your questions. There is no obligation to join us as you discover more about faith and later, more specifically, Catholic faith.

The decision is ultimately yours to discern if this is to be your spiritual home. The invitation is always open; contact Dcn. Jerome at dcn.jerome@stamadison.org.

Rosebud Program


Prayer is part of our Catholic faith, and everyone is in need of prayers throughout their lives. The Rosebud Program is a way for parents and grandparents to request prayers and support for anyone who is pregnant, celebrating birth or adoption, grieving miscarriage, stillbirth, abortion, infant or child death or waiting to become pregnant or adopt.

Here is how it works: **In the Gathering Area by the statue of Mary**, there are a variety of colored roses and cards that address the needs listed above. Each rose represents a special need. The person wanting prayers writes their name on the card matching their prayer request and the appropriate colored rose and then puts it into the vase. The prayers are put onto the prayer chain.

I have just removed the roses to give others the opportunity to put in their requests. Your prayer request is being prayed for by the people on the prayer chain. In less than a month, the St. Thomas Aquinas Music Ministry will return to our “normal” fall rehearsal schedule for the first time since before the pandemic began. There are many opportunities for students and adults to become involved. If you are currently involved as a musician, choir member, or cantor here at St. Thomas Aquinas, THANK YOU! If you are not currently involved in our music ministry, NOW is the time to consider becoming involved!

Cantors/Small Group Singers: (Saturday 4:30p.m./ Sunday 8:00a.m./Summer Months–Sunday 10:00 a.m.)

The cantors’ and singers’ primary function is to support and encourage the congregation in singing. They are our song leaders, animators, and psalmists. These small groups of singers share their gifts and talents year-round. – Join any time.

STA Parish Choir: (Sunday 10:00a.m. – Sept–May)

The STA Parish Choir sings weekly at the 10:00 a.m. Sunday Mass. In addition, this group sings for evening Holy Day Masses, Midnight Mass, Christmas Day, Holy Week, Easter, Confirmation, and other special liturgical celebrations during the church year. Open to students (grades 7+) and adults. Rehearsals are Thursdays from 6:30-8:30 p.m. The ability to read music is helpful, but not necessary. – Our first rehearsal is scheduled for **Thursday, September 8**. Please contact me ahead of time if you are interested in joining us or would like more info so that things can be prepared for our first rehearsal.

STA Choristers: (Saturday 4:30p.m. &/or Sunday 10:00a.m., Once or Twice a Month – September–May)

The STA Choristers (Children’s Choir) sing monthly at the 4:30p.m. Saturday Mass and/or the Sunday 10:00a.m. Mass. In addition, this group has the opportunity to sing for other celebrations, including Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Eve Masses. This choir sings from September through May each year, and is open to students (grades 3-8) as well as high school students. Students should be able to read well in order to keep up at rehearsals and Masses! Rehearsals are most often on Wednesday from 5-6p.m. – Our first rehearsal is scheduled for **Wednesday, September 7 at 5:00p.m.** Please share the word and let’s get some more of our students involved!

STA Spanish Choir: (Saturday 6:30 p.m.)

The STA Spanish Choir sings weekly at the 6:30 p.m. Saturday Mass. This choir joins the STA Parish Choir for bilingual celebrations throughout the liturgical year. This choir sings year round and is open to students (grades 7+) and adults. Rehearsals are on Saturdays at 5:30p.m. before the 6:30 p.m. Spanish Mass. – Join any time. Contact me for more information or come and join us on Saturday at 5:30 p.m. in the Music Room!

Instrumentalists & Accompanists: (All Masses)

Instrumentalists and accompanists (piano and/or organ) are encouraged to join our music ministry, depending upon experience. Audition required.


