- * Offering pro-life resources and information in the Sunday bulletin and offering a pro-life display in the gathering area.
- * Age-appropriate Respect Life lesson as part of our faith formation program.
- * Working with all Diocesan Parishes to help women in our community choose life, called "Walking with Moms in need."



June 2022 - June 2023 Year of Diocesan Revival

This first year of the Revival invites diocesan staff, bishops, and priests to respond to the Lord's personal invitation and equips them to share this love with the faithful through eucharistic congresses and events.

June 2023 - July 2024 Year of Parish Revival

The second phase will foster Eucharistic devotion at the parish level, strengthening our liturgical life through faithful celebration of the Mass, Eucharistic adoration, missions, resources, preaching, and organic movements of the Holy Spirit.

July 17 - 21, 2024 National Eucharistic Congress

At this historic event, more than 80,000 Catholics of all ages will gather in Indianapolis to reconsecrate their hearts to the source and summit of our faith.

July 2024 - July 2025 National Year of Mission

Having enkindled a missionary fire in the hearts of the American faithful, the Holy Spirit will send us out on mission to share the gift of our Eucharistic Lord as we enter the universal Church's jubilee year in 2025.


How to Pray the Rosary

- 1. Make the Sign of the Cross and say the Apostles Creed.
- 2. Say the Our Father.
- 3. Say three Hail Marys.
- 4. Say the Glory be to the Father.
- 5. Announce the First Mystery; then say the Our Father.
- 6. Say ten Hail Marys, while meditating on the Mystery.
- 7. Say the Glory be to the Father.
- 8. Announce the Second Mystery: then say the Our Father. Repeat 6 and 7 and continue with the Third, Fourth, and Fifth Mysteries in the same manner.
- 9. Say the Hail, Holy Queen on the medal after the five decades are completed.

Mysteries of the Rosary

The Mysteries traditionally adhere to certain days of the week.

Monday: Joyful Tuesday: Sorrowful Wednesday: Glorious Thursday: Luminous Friday: Sorrowful Saturday: Joyful Sunday: Glorious

- 4. Reza Gloria al Padre.
- 5. Anuncia el Primer Misterio; luego reza el Padre Nuestro.
- 6. Reza diez Avemarías, mientras meditas en el Misterio.
- 7. Reza Gloria al Padre. (Después de cada década se puede rezar la Oración de Fátima)
- 8. Anuncia el Segundo Misterio: luego reza el Padre Nuestro. Repetir 6 y 7 y continuar con los Misterios Tercero, Cuarto y Quinto de la misma manera.
- 9. Reza La Salve en la medalla después de que se completen las cinco décadas.

Season of Creation concludes on October 4, the Feast of St. Francis

The Season of Creation comes to an end with the Feast of St. Francis on October 4. How fitting that we close the season with the saint named the Patron Saint of Ecologists in 1979 by Pope John Paul II. This Pope reminded us in his *Angelus* in 1982 "not to behave like dissident predators where nature is concerned, but to assume responsibility for it, taking all care so that everything stays healthy and integrated, so as to offer a welcoming and friendly environment even to those who succeed us." And in his statement on the World Day of Peace in 1990, the Pope said that Francis "invited all of creation – animals, plants, natural forces, even Brother Sun and Sister Moon – to give honor and praise to the Lord."

Thank you for participating in this season through daily prayer for healing of God's creation and renewing your commitment to lifestyle changes. We pray that you continue your new habits and find more ways to better care for creation.

Thank you to all who received our gift of energy efficient LED light bulbs last weekend. Replacing old light bulbs with more energy efficient bulbs helps to not only lower your carbon footprint but also saves you money--money that could be donated to help those effected by natural disasters made more severe due to rising temperatures. If you already have replaced all your old bulbs, consider giving the bulbs to a neighbor or family member. Sharing your commitment to caring for God's creation will inspire them to do the same and may even lead to them joining you for Mass some Sunday.



Gospel Reflection

Luke 17:5-10

"Increase our faith." Today's Gospel begins with this plea from the apostles to Jesus. But what could have prompted this request? If we look at the line in the Gospel of Luke just previous to this selection, Jesus says "If [your bother]

wrongs you seven times in one day and returns to you seven times saying 'I am sorry,' you should forgive him." Ooof. No wonder the apostles want an increase in faith. What Jesus is telling his apostles in the remainder of the Gospel is that being a disciple goes beyond doing the bare minimum of what was required by the religious rules and regulations of the time. And so should it be with us. But it is hard. What Habakkuk says in the first reading is equally true today: "There is strife, and clamorous discord." Being a forgiving and open disciple is difficult in such an environment. But it is what we are called to do as Christians.

Formally known as *Parish Life*, this newly (re)launched ministry is looking to begin serving later this holiday season! Hospitality & Parish Events Ministry at Saint Thomas Aquinas Catholic Parish is a ministry responsible for the planning, food serving, set-up and clean-up of parish events and gatherings.

Join us October 18th 6:30-8pm in the Social Hall for our Hospitality & Parish Events Ministry kick- off meeting. All are invited!

The new leadership team will introduce the various teams of the ministry, share the event schedule, and describe how you can sign up.

The Hospitality & Parish Life Ministry has multiple teams. Members are welcome to be a part of as many teams as they would like.

- 1. <u>Weekend Hospitality Team:</u> Responsible for setting up beverages and donuts after 10am weekend Mass, creating an atmosphere of excellent hospitality, as a way for parishioners to get to know other parishioners. This team may also be asked to host small gatherings such as setting up refreshments after Confirmation or other weekend events.
- 2. <u>Funeral Luncheon Ministry:</u> Responsible for setting up beverages and food for luncheons after funerals or burial services. This is a wonderful way to support our parish families in their time of sorrow.
- 3. <u>Laundry and Cleaning Team:</u> This team helps between events to make sure the kitchen and social hall are clean and ready for events. This team is responsible for laundering towels and tablecloths, sorting silverware, cleaning tasks (eg. refrigerator shelves) and organizing kitchen materials.
- 4. <u>STA Feast Day: Annual Spaghetti Supper Team:</u> The Spaghetti Supper is an annual event at STA in January. Due to its large scale, this event has its own team. This team will be responsible for assigning duties for the event such as cooking, set-up, serving, clean-up and more.

5. Parish Events Hospitality Team(s):

- a. <u>Setup Team:</u> Responsible for setting up beverages, food stations and table centerpieces for special events in the Social Hall creating an atmosphere of excellent hospitality. This team may also assist with setting up tables and chairs in the Social Hall.
- b. <u>Meal Prep Team:</u> Responsible for creating a menu, shopping for supplies and cooking and prepping meals for events in the Social Hall.
- c. <u>Servers & Greeters Team:</u> Serving food and/or refreshing food & drink stations. Responsible for offering an initial greeting as people come through the doors, helping them find a table and making them feel welcome at the event.
- d <u>Clean-up & Dishwashing Team:</u> Responsible for clean-up after the event. Duties include: dishwashing, kitchen cleaning, food storage, putting away Social Hall decorations, vacuuming the Social Hall, etc.


