

In your wise and loving care, you made your servant teacher of all your Church. He did the work of Christ on earth.


May your Son welcome him into eternal glory.

May your servant whom you appointed high priest of your flock be counted now among the priests in the life of your kingdom.



# Illuminate Speaker Series: Gracie Morbitzer

#### We Can All Be Saints: Exploring Your Gifts with the Modern Saints—January 26

On Thursday, January 26<sup>th</sup>, 6:30 PM, come and meet Gracie Morbitzer, a young artist based in Ohio, whose mission is to reimagine the extraordinary saints of our Catholic tradition as modern, everyday humans who remind us of ourselves. Gracie asserts, "We're going to need a saint of computer programming, and we're going to need a saint of lacrosse and basketball. You can use your passions to make the world a better place—YOU can be that saint!"

#### **About Gracie's Icons**

In Gracie's view, most of the ancient icons of saints tend to portray everyone as expressionless and hard to tell apart. But, she reminds us, the saints were hopeless, spunky, terrified, lonely, individualistic, rebellious, progressive, loving, ambitious, counter-cultural, or boisterous outcasts and sinners, who with God's grace reached beyond themselves and made the world and themselves so much better. In her icons, she portrays saints with their correct ethnicities to show the Church's more widespread, though sometimes hidden, diversity. She gives each saint a personality and a human expression, with a modern twist. To further this notion of extraordinary coming from ordinary, she has painted each on a discarded or thrifted piece of wood. Much like the saints, each plaque once forgotten was transformed and is now revered. You can find Gracie's work at www.themodernsaints.com.

# **Gospel Reflection**

#### **Epiphany**

I am originally from Missouri, the "Show Me" state. The sobriquet possibly comes from a Missouri Congressman who gave a speech in which he said ". . . frothy eloquence neither convinces nor

satisfies me. I am from Missouri. You have got to show me."

Epiphany is sort of God's answer to the world's "Show me!" The Epiphany is God revealing to the people of the whole world, personified by the three magi, just how much he loved them – he became one of them. Prophets throughout the Old Testament spoke of the messiah's coming, John the Baptist prepared the way, and finally Jesus was born, both God and man. At Christmas we celebrate this birth, and at Epiphany we celebrate his revelation to the world. At that first Epiphany there was an exchange of gifts: the magi brought gold, frankincense and myrrh, and God gifted himself to the salvation of the world.

In some parts of the world, it is traditional to exchange gifts on Epiphany as well as Christmas in imitation of the magi who brought their gifts to the Lord. This Epiphany, as our new year begins, perhaps we should think about what gifts we too will bring to the Lord.
