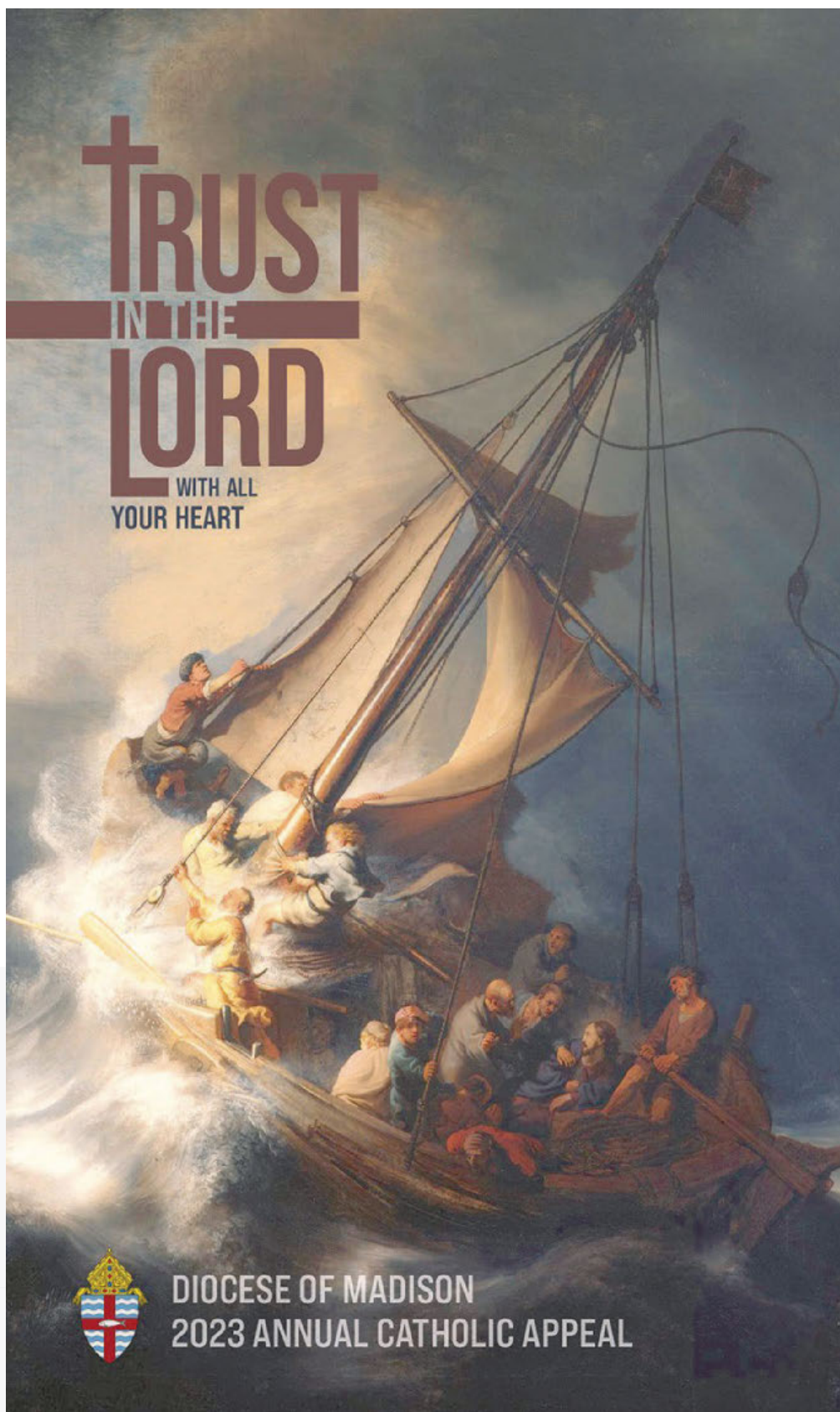

Feast of St. Blaise—February 3

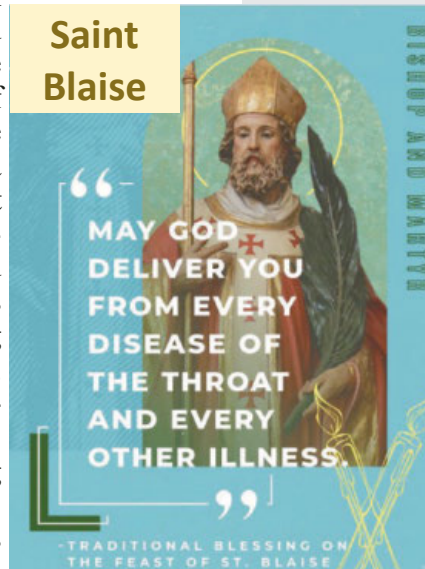
Fiesta de San Blas—3 de febrero

February 3, Feast Day of St. Blaise, Bishop and Martyr

On Friday, February 3, we celebrated the feast of St. Blaise. We will commemorate St. Blaise's Feast day at the conclusion of our weekend Masses this weekend with individual blessing of throats with the blessed candles.

St. Blaise was a physician who later in life was ordained to the priesthood and eventually was made Bishop of Sebaste in Armenia. When the persecution of Christians began, he took refuge in the hills. He was discovered living in a cave, by men who had been sent to hunt him down under an order of the governor. While in prison awaiting trial and torture, Blaise performed a miraculous cure of a young boy who was choking to death on a fish bone. In gratitude, the boy's mother brought Blaise candles and food while he was imprisoned. It is because of the miraculous healing of the little boy that devotions to St. Blaise for healing of throat ailments grew through the centuries and is still performed today.



3 de febrero, Fiesta de San Blas, Obispo y Mártir

El viernes 3 de febrero celebramos la fiesta de San Blas. Conmemoraremos la fiesta de San Blas al final de nuestras Misas Dominicales este fin de semana con la bendición individual de las gargantas utilizando las velas bendecidas.

San Blas fue un médico que más tarde en su vida fue ordenado sacerdote y finalmente fue nombrado Obispo de Sebaste en Armenia. Cuando comenzó la persecución de los cristianos, se refugió en las colinas. Fue descubierto viviendo en una cueva por unos hombres que habían sido enviados a buscarlo por orden del gobernador. Mientras estaba en prisión a la espera de juicio y tortura, Blas curó milagrosamente a un niño que se estaba ahogando con una espina de pescado. En agradecimiento, la madre del niño le llevó velas y comida durante su encarcelamiento. Debido a la curación milagrosa del niño, la devoción a San Blas para la curación de las enfermedades de garganta creció a lo largo de los siglos y todavía se realiza hoy en día.

Annual Catholic Appeal

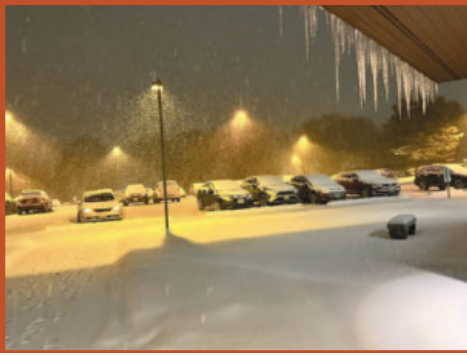

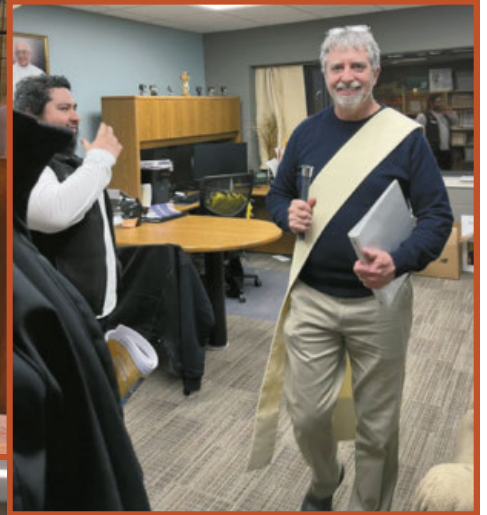
Spaghetti Supper and Open House

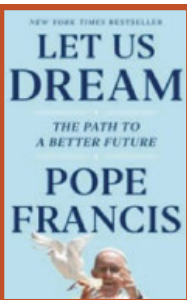

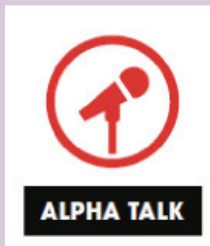


What does Alpha look like?



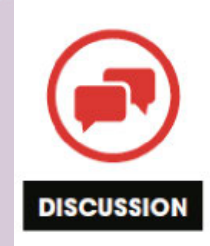
GOOD FOOD

Gospel Reflection

Matthew 5:13-16

“You are the light of the world,” Jesus tells us today. But what is light? Scientists usually describe light as tiny packets with 2 separate but related properties – they say light acts as both a wave and as a particle.

Using this duality, I want to investigate spiritual light. How can we act as spiritual light? We can be both wave and particle. First, a wave. A spiritual light wave seems to be something invisible, but powerful, something that pours forth in a constant, inexorable swell – something like faith. Paul says to us in our second reading today: “I came to you. . . that your faith may not rest on human wisdom, but on the power of God.” Our faith is a wave that pushes outward from us, lifting all those whom it contacts.

But light is also a particle, and that seems something more concrete, something more tangible; very much like the good works as mentioned in the first reading, where the author notes that by performing good works, then “our light will break forth like the dawn.”

So, we have both wave and particle; faith and works. But we can do *even more* with light (at least visible light); we can break it apart with a prism to see a spectrum. A spectrum is the rainbow of colors we see that combine to create white light. Now, if we break apart spiritual light through the prism of today’s readings, we can see what elements compose that light. The result, as described in the first reading, are those things that combine to make us light for others: share your bread with the hungry, shelter the oppressed and the homeless, clothe the naked, do not turn your back on others. These are the elements that compose the spectrum of spiritual light. And it should come as no surprise that this Gospel reading from Matthew today comes immediately after the Beatitudes we heard last Sunday. So let us go forth and be a light to the world!

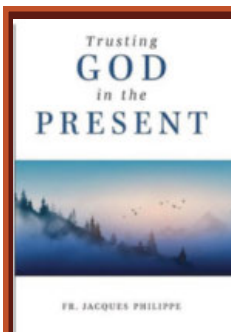

For the sick, especially those nearing life's end:
