

## Words from Dcn. Jerome

## Gospel Reflection—Matthew 25:1-13 by Dcn. Jerome

One of the interesting aspects of today's Gospel reading about the ten virgins is that while they were waiting for the bridegroom, they ALL fell asleep, the wise as well as the foolish. This emphasizes even more the wisdom of the five wise virgins in their preparation. Because they had put thought, effort and resources (buying extra oil) ahead of time, they were prepared for the bridegroom's coming, even though they fell asleep as well. In fact, as the footnote in my Catholic Study Bible tells me, the 'stay awake' command at the end of the Gospel may simply mean 'be prepared.' This can be both a relief and a warning for us. A relief because, just like in real life, it is difficult to go without sleep. In this Gospel's context, I know in my daily life, there are many times that I am not thinking about Christ's coming, there are times when I am 'sleeping.' The warning is, for those times we are sleeping, we should have prepared ourselves for the bridegroom's return. How do we prepare ourselves? By knowing Jesus, having that relationship with him, following him and his commands and doing the will of the Father. Look at the similarities between the end of this Gospel and Matthew 7:21-24, in which Jesus talks about true discipleship. So, as we prepare to celebrate Christ's coming in rapidly approaching Advent, even if we briefly fall asleep, we do not want to hear him say: "I do not know you."

#### Mass of St. Ann at St. Thomas Aquinas!

As we continue to work more closely within our Pastorate of St. Thomas Aquinas and Our Lady Queen of Peace, you will notice changes and adjustments to some of our procedures. #### Christmas Food Basket **Time Is Right Around** the Corner!

During the Christmas season, you can make a difference by sharing food with GIFTS FROM THE HEART our neighbors in need. This year's Christmas Food Baskets will be important as many of our neighbors are struggling due to the effects of inflation. Food donations to fill the 125 baskets will be collected starting November 25-26 and will continue through December 15.

- 1. If you are coming to the STA campus, you can bring your food donations and put them in the brown bins as usual.
- 2. There will be a Reverse Collection the weekend of December 2-3rd. Instead of just putting something into the collection basket, you'll be taking something out! Each person will take a slip of paper out of the basket, and on that slip is a food item that we would like you to bring back.
- 3. Financial donations are also most welcome. Checks should be made payable to St. Thomas Aguinas Catholic Church, with the notation "Christmas Food Baskets."
- 4. We will be sorting and packing donations on Friday, December 15. We will start sorting and packing donations at 6 pm and work until we are done. This is a great multigenerational activity!
- 5. The delivery of the baskets will take place Saturday, December 16 starting at 9 am. As in years past, we need many volunteers to deliver the baskets.

#### **Thanksgiving Day Offering** Collection benefits STA and **QP SVdP Conferences**

Our STA conference of St Vincent de Paul has had its busiest year yet. Through your



donations this past year we have been able to offer financial assistance to our own parishioners and our neighbors. We have helped 169 households with a total of 498 people. We have helped a young mother of three with a new premie baby with health needs pay her utility bill. We helped a number of people who are chronically poor with assistance for rent to prevent eviction or paid utilities to prevent electricity cut offs. We helped a vision impaired parishioner move into new subsidized housing to better meet her needs. We paid the rent for a mom of 5 who had car problems and couldn't pay both rent and the car repairs. She needed the car to get to work. The rent payment allowed her to stay on the waiting list for a Habitat for Humanity home. These are just a few of the people we serve.

It is a blessing for us to be able to offer monetary assistance as well as prayer for the persons we help. It is a joy to see their relief and gratitude. Our financial assistance generally comes completely from our parish although this past year we requested and received a SVdP Friends of the Poor grant for \$5,000. Our expenses included \$15,061 for housing, \$3,894 in clothing and furniture, \$3,311 for utilities, \$3,192 for transportation, and \$938 in other needs.

Our Vincentians are missionary disciples. We personally meet with our neighbors, listen to their stories, learn about their needs and provide help. We have delivered food, diapers and furniture, we connect them to services that can provide specific help. We pray for all those we contact and we pray with them. This is a ministry where we personally encounter Christ in those we meet.

We ask for your continued financial support. We have been blessed with a very giving parish and individuals who donate. Every month we pass the hat among our members. Our deepest thanks to those whose giving allows us to feed, clothe and house the poor. If you won't make the Thanksgiving Mass, you can always drop off a check to STA with Thanksgiving collection or SVDP in the comment section.

We also are always open to new members joining our conference. If you strive to be a witness to Christ, develop true friendships and serve others, we would love to have you join us. There are many ways to volunteer on your schedule.


