

## From Fr. Brian Wilk, Parochial Administrator Friends,



The number of the New Year is split at the beginning and end.


The initials C + M + B represent the three kings: CASPER, MELCHOIR, AND BALTHASAR.

They may also stand for "Christus mansionem benedicat," "May Christ bless this house."

Take the piece of chalk, gather around the inside of the front door. Use the chalk to inscribe the numbers and letters on your door frame, while praying:

May God, who provided a safe dwelling for the eternal Word, bless our house and all the people who live here. Throughout the year, may those who go through our front door enjoy the blessing of Christ. We pray especially for world Peace in 2024. We ask these things through Christ our Lord. Amen.



## Gospel Reflection of Matthew 2:1-12 by Dcn. Jerome

Today is the Feast of the Epiphany, when the magi from the east arrive in Jerusalem to do homage to "the newborn king of the Jews." I have often wondered - what was their reaction when arriving in Jerusalem? Were they surprised that there were no celebrations taking place for the new king-to-be? Were they shocked that the current ruler, Herod, knew nothing about it? Were they disappointed at the lowliness of the house where the star stopped? Were they shocked and doubtful that the baby they saw there would someday be "king of the Jews?" Yet, despite any surprises, disappointment or shock they may have had initially, when they beheld the baby Jesus they prostrated themselves and did him homage. There will be many times in our lives and in our lives of faith when we will feel surprised or disappointed or shocked. Yet if we, like the magi, keep Christ as our center and recognize God in our midst, then as our first reading today says "upon you the Lord shines" and the darkness of doubt will be driven away.


#### **Encounter Jesus!**
