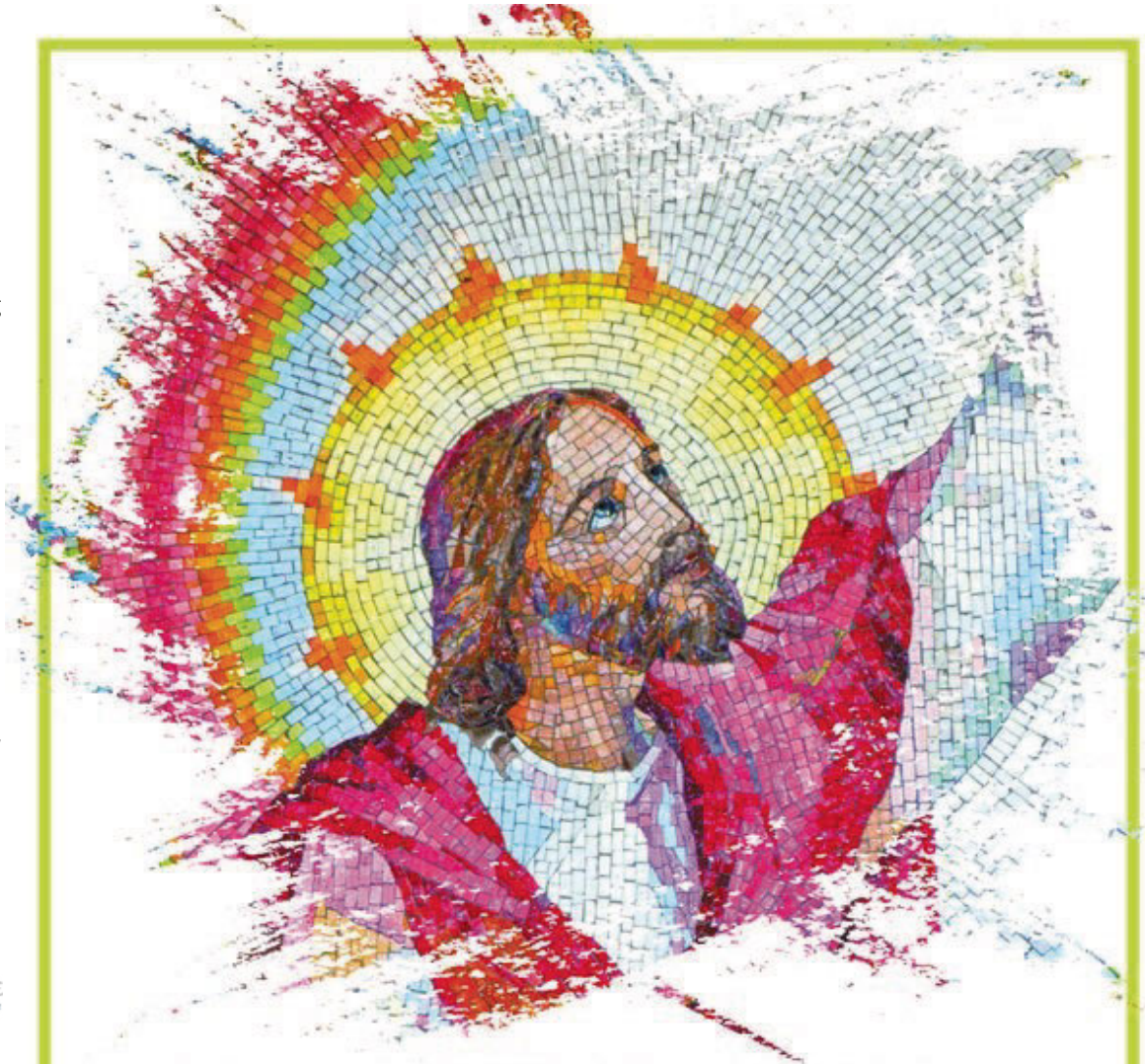

Words from Fr. Brian Wilk Parochial Administrator

In this weekend's Gospel passage from Luke, the primary interest is to show that the risen Jesus is the same person the Apostles had known prior to his crucifixion. Luke emphasizes the reality of Jesus' bodily resurrection but makes it clear that the resurrection is not a return to earthly life. Jesus has risen to a new life beyond death.

The resurrection means that Jesus lives, and we too can encounter him in faith. We encounter him especially in the "breaking of the bread," that is in the Eucharist. He will be with us wherever we are, helping us to give meaning and beauty to our lives. And like the Apostles we are commissioned to bring this good news to others.

On a personal note, I will be leaving on Monday for a pilgrimage trip to Italy with Bishop Hying and sixty other pilgrims. We will be visiting Florence, Venice, Assisi and Rome. Pilgrimages are a wonderful opportunity for faith, fellowship and spiritual growth. Please keep us in your prayers. We will be returning on the 26th of April. I look forward to seeing you when we return. In my absence Msgr. Gunn will be "acting" administrator of the pastorate.

Gospel Reflection of Luke 24:35-48 by Dcn. Jerome Buhman

They thought they were seeing a ghost. That's what Luke tells us today about the disciples when Jesus appeared to them. But nothing could be further from the truth. Especially if you think in modern terms of the word "ghost." To "ghost" today means to suddenly end all communication with someone with whom you have been in close contact. This is perhaps what the apostles feared when Jesus was crucified – that they would never see or hear from Jesus again. But of course, Jesus did return, and not only that, he promised to be with them (and us!) til the end of time.

In the last line of today's Gospel, Jesus says "You are witnesses of these things," speaking not just about his death and resurrection, but about his entire life, words and work. He is speaking not just to the disciples, but to us, and we are to be his witnesses in the world today. And to help us, he has sent us his Spirit, or as it is also called, the Holy Ghost, which gives a whole new, and radically different, meaning to the word "ghosting."


