



Gospel Reflection of John 10:11-18 by Dcn. Jerome Buhman

"I have other sheep who do not belong to this fold." This line in John's Gospel underscores the universal nature of Christ's mission. Jesus came for all. All the members of each different "fold," secular or religious, in the world are called to be a member of one "fold" following Jesus.

At the time this Gospel was being written, the early Church was expanding outward from its Jewish roots, quickly spreading across the known world. One of the earliest challenges facing the Church at that time was whether adherents needed to follow all the Jewish laws to be Christian or whether Gentiles (non-Jews) could be members without having to follow those laws. It was decided that you did not have to adhere to all Jewish laws to belong to Christ's Church. The Gospel is for everyone. Like the early church, there are questions today that plague the world both inside and outside the Church concerning various aspects of "belonging." In these days of division and polarization, it is sometimes difficult to remember that we all belong to one fold. Our challenge is to overcome our divisions to become one in following the Good Shepherd.
