

This weekend we celebrate the Ascension of Jesus into heaven. It is not a day for mourning or sadness. It is a day for openness and joy. Before leaving his apostles, Jesus commissioned them to preach the Gospel to the whole world. To carry out that mission he promised to send them the Holy Spirit. On Pentecost he fulfilled that promise.

We live in the hope that the words of Jesus will come true for us, that where he is, we too shall be. Meanwhile, we all have a task to do. It is to preach the Gospel and be his witnesses in the world.

Gospel Reflection: Mark 16:15-20 by Dcn. Jerome Buhman

Today we celebrate the feast of Ascension. Too often on this feast, I think we focus only on what is happening in the sky: the actual ascension of Jesus. But just as important is what occurs on the ground. The two men in white ask: "Men of Galilee, why are you standing there looking at the sky?" They are asking us the same question. The Gospel tells us that Jesus said to his followers: "You will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, throughout Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth." These words, too, are for us. This Gospel is not just about Jesus going "up," but also about us going out. We are commissioned by our baptism to be witnesses for Jesus in the world. Our personal liturgical and prayer life is vital, but so is our witnessing in the world outside our church building and outside our homes. So we can't just stand and look up, we must go out and witness.

En Español

Este fin de semana celebramos la Ascensión de Jesús al cielo. No es un día de luto ni de tristeza. Es un día para la apertura y la alegría. Reflexión del Evangelio **Marc 16,15-20 del deacano Jerome**

Hoy celebramos la fiesta de la Ascensión. Creo que con demasiada frecuencia en esta fiesta nos centramos sólo en lo que está sucediendo en el cielo: la ascensión real de Jesús. Pero igualmente importante es lo que ocurre sobre la tierra. Los dos hombres vestidos de blanco preguntan: "Hombres galileos, ¿por qué estáis ahí mirando al cielo?" Nos hacen la misma pregunta. El Evangelio nos cuenta que Jesús dijo a sus seguidores: "Ustedes serán mis testigos en Jerusalén, en toda Judea y Samaria, y hasta los confines de la tierra". Estas palabras también son para nosotros. Este Evangelio no se trata sólo de que Jesús "suba", sino también de que nosotros salgamos. Nuestro bautismo nos encarga ser testigos de Jesús en el mundo. Nuestra vida litúrgica y de oración personal es vital, pero también lo es nuestro testimonio en el mundo fuera del edificio de nuestra iglesia y fuera de nuestros hogares. Así que no podemos simplemente quedarnos de pie y mirar hacia arriba, debemos salir y testificar.

That day also marks the beginning of Laudato Si' Week (May 19-26) which recognizes the 9th anniversary of the publication of *Laudato Si': On Care for our Common Home*, Pope Francis' profound encyclical. If you haven't read it, now is the time. You can read or download it from the Vatican website vatican.va/content/francesco/en/encyclicals or purchase new and used copies of the book online by simply searching for *Laudato Si'*. If you have read it, consider another reading.

Pope Francis reminds us that his namesake, St. Francis, often referred to other creatures as 'brother' or 'sister', suggesting that this perspective "cannot be written off as naive romanticism, for it affects the choices which determine our behaviour... if we feel intimately united with all that exists, then sobriety and care will well up spontaneously." [LS 11]

Let us examine our perspective, take the time to "smell the roses," wonder at God's gift and treat all creation with respect and love. God's love is unconditional and magnanimous. Let us share His love not only with our fellow human beings, but with the creatures and fruits of the earth that we share this planet with. Consider what changes you can make so that you feel connected to and protective of all of God's creation.


