Gospel Reflection: Mt 28:16-20 by Dcn. Jerome Buhman

There is an astounding line in our reading today from the very end of Matthew's Gospel. Jesus gathers on the mountainside with his disciples – the disciples with whom he had ministered for three years, the disciples who had heard his profound words, who had seen his many miracles, who had seen him crucified AND had seen him after he rose from the dead – and yet it is said that when they saw Jesus, the disciples “worshipped, but they doubted.” Holy Smokes, you might be thinking, how could they have experienced all that and doubted? Yet that phrase should give us great hope and comfort. Because Jesus then does something extraordinary with these doubters. He does not reprimand or belittle them for lack of faith. He commissions them to spread his Gospel. I think if we are all honest, we would admit that at some point in our lives we have experienced some form of doubt in our faith. Some of our greatest saints have admitted that much. Yet Jesus still loves and cherishes us. And despite any doubts we might have he also commissions us to spread his Gospel. So if you have doubts, do not despair, for as Jesus tells his disciples “*I am with you always until the end of the age.*”

Around the Diocese

Update to Suggested Amounts for Mass Stipends & Stole Fee

The Diocese of Madison and our parishes are grateful to all those who have generously provided a donation for Masses, funerals, weddings, and quinceañeras in the past. The donation for these sacraments and services has remained the same for thirty years throughout the dioceses of Wisconsin. Recently, when the Bishops of the State of Wisconsin gathered, they decreed that stipends should be adjusted to reflect the current time and to account for inflation. The new suggested stipend structure is as follows:

Mass Stipends—\$20
Funerals—\$75
Marriages—\$100
Quinceañeras—\$100

These new suggested amounts take effect with events that occur on or after July 1, 2024. They do not apply retroactively to those who have already paid the appropriate amount for an upcoming event (even one that falls after July 1, 2024). The new fee structure will be applied to all *new* requests we receive for events that occur on or after July 1, 2024.

As always, if someone is not able to offer the stipend, the parish is always happy to provide the sacrament or service with no fee.

New Parishioner Database and Online Giving Platform

ParishStaq will replace our current platform ParishSOFT as our new digital hub for parish information, registration, updates, and financial giving. It's a dynamic Catholic Church management system that will also integrate with our new payment and giving software: **PushPay**.

What is PushPay?

PushPay is an online giving platform and will replace our current online giving platforms like PayPal and SQUARE. PushPay provides a wide variety of giving options, including frequency of gifts and types of collections. PushPay accepts Visa, MasterCard, American Express, and Discover, as well as ACH (checking or savings accounts) gifts.

Why should I enroll in PushPay?

- Create a PushPay account and manage your online giving throughout the year!
- Make a donation with a credit or debit card or link your bank account to give via ACH direct debit
- Set up recurring donations without having to write a check or bring an envelope to Mass
- Make a one-time gift or give to a special fund or collection
- View your giving history and giving statements
- Manage your payment methods and edit your recurring payment amount at any time



What's Next?

- We are making an important upgrade to our parish management software, which includes switching to a new online donation system (PushPay). This is the first step during the transition to ParishStaq.
- **If you would like to keep giving by envelopes or cash in the offertory basket, there is nothing you need to do at this time.**
- **If you currently give online (or would like to start), you are invited to enroll with PushPay.**

 - ◇ **ACH/Credit Card autopay members:** For those enrolled in our monthly 4th Tuesday autopay via ACH bank transfer or credit card payment, it is up to you if you would like to switch to PushPay. If you would like to make the switch, please call or email the STA Business Office and we will stop your monthly 4th Tuesday autopay, to avoid duplicate payments.
 - ◇ If you do not know the method of payment you are currently using or would like to discuss the options – please contact the Business Office.
 - ◇ **PayPal users:** If you have set up recurring payments with PayPal, you will need to login to your PayPal account to cancel that. Please be sure to stop your PayPal recurring payments before setting up payments in PushPay to avoid double payments. www.paypal.com/signin
 - ◇ **SQUARE users:** If you have set up recurring payments with SQUARE, you will need to login to your SQUARE account to cancel that. Please be sure to stop your SQUARE recurring payments before setting up payments in PushPay to avoid double payments. squareup.com/login
- Since we don't keep your credit card or banking information on file, we cannot simply transfer your information to the new system. Plus, having you create your new PushPay account and enter your own information and log-in credentials helps protect your data.
- **Thank you** so much for helping us with this important transition. The new parish management software is a big improvement that will save time for our staff, allow us better data management, and streamline communication.

Es un sistema dinámico de gestión de la Iglesia Católica que también se integrará con nuestro nuevo software de pago y donaciones: **PushPay**.

Una nueva forma de apoyar a St. Thomas Aquinas: PushPay Online Giving

PushPay es una plataforma de donaciones en línea dentro del paquete ParishStaq. Reemplazará nuestras actuales plataformas de donaciones en línea como PayPal y SQUARE. PushPay ofrece una amplia variedad de opciones de donaciones, incluida la frecuencia de las donaciones y los tipos de cobros. PushPay acepta regalos con Visa, MasterCard, American Express y Discover, así como con cuentas corrientes o de ahorro. Le invitamos a inscribirse en PushPay durante nuestra transición a ParishStaq.



Lo que sigue:

- Estamos realizando una actualización importante de nuestro software de gestión parroquial que incluye el cambio a un nuevo sistema de donación en línea. Si usted es uno de nuestros donantes en línea actuales, necesitamos su ayuda: comenzaremos con la inscripción en PushPay. **Este es el primer paso durante la transición a ParishStaq.**
- Si desea seguir dando en sobres o dinero en efectivo en la canasta del ofertorio, no hay nada que deba hacer en este momento.
- Si actualmente dona en línea (o le gustaría comenzar), se le invita a cambiar a PushPay. Escanee el código QR para comenzar con PushPay o visite stamadison.org/donate
 - ◇ **Miembros de pago automático de ACH/tarjeta de crédito:** Para aquellos inscritos en nuestro pago automático del 4º martes a través de transferencia bancaria ACH o pago con tarjeta de crédito, depende de usted si desea cambiar a PushPay. Si desea hacer el cambio, llame o envíe un correo electrónico a la Oficina Comercial de STA y detendremos su pago automático del 4º martes.
 - ◇ Si no conoce el método de pago que está utilizando actualmente o desea discutir las opciones, comuníquese con la Oficina Comercial.
 - ◇ **Usuarios de PayPal:** Si ha configurado pagos recurrentes con PayPal, deberá iniciar sesión en su cuenta de PayPal para cancelarlo. Asegúrese de detener sus pagos recurrentes de PayPal antes de configurar los pagos en PushPay para evitar pagos dobles.
 - ◇ **Usuarios de SQUARE:** Si ha configurado pagos recurrentes con SQUARE, deberá iniciar sesión en su cuenta de SQUARE para cancelarlo. Asegúrate de detener tus pagos recurrentes de SQUARE antes de configurar los pagos en PushPay para evitar pagos dobles.
- Dado que no guardamos su tarjeta de crédito o información bancaria en el archivo, no podemos simplemente transferir su información al nuevo sistema. Además, el hecho de que cree su nueva cuenta e ingrese su propia información y credenciales de inicio de sesión ayuda a proteger sus datos.
- **Muchas gracias** por ayudarnos con esta importante transición. El nuevo software de gestión parroquial es una gran mejora que ahorrará tiempo a nuestro personal, nos permitirá una mejor gestión de los datos y agilizará la comunicación.

Reflexión del Evangelio de Mateo 28,16-20 del deacono Jerome

He aquí una línea asombrosa de nuestra lectura de hoy, del final del Evangelio de San Mateo. Jesús se reúne en la ladera de la montaña con sus discípulos -los discípulos con los que había ministrado durante tres años, los discípulos que habían escuchado sus profundas palabras, que habían visto sus muchos muertos, que lo habían visto crucificado Y lo habían visto después de resucitar de entre los muertos- y, sin embargo, se dice que cuando vieron a Jesús, los discípulos "lo adoraron, pero dudaron". Santo Cielo, estarás pensando - ¿cómo pudieron haber experimentado todo eso y dudar? Sin embargo, esa frase debería darnos una gran esperanza y consuelo. Porque Jesús hace algo extraordinario con estos escépticos: no los reprende ni los menosprecia por su falta de fe, sino que les encarga que difundan su Evangelio. Creo que si todos somos sinceros, admitiríamos que en algún momento de nuestras vidas hemos experimentado alguna forma de duda en nuestra fe; algunos de nuestros mayores santos lo han admitido. Sin embargo, Jesús nos sigue amando y apreciando. Y a pesar de las dudas que podamos tener, también nos encarga que difundamos su Evangelio. Así que si tienes dudas, no desesperes, porque como Jesús dice a sus discípulos "Yo estoy con ustedes todos los días hasta el fin del mundo."

La donación para estos sacramentos y servicios ha permanecido igual durante treinta años en todas las diócesis de Wisconsin. Recientemente, cuando los Obispos del Estado de Wisconsin se reunieron, decretaron que los estipendios debían ajustarse para reflejar el tiempo actual y tener en cuenta la inflación.

La nueva estructura de estipendios sugerida es la siguiente:

Estipendios para Misas - \$20

Funerales - \$75

Matrimonios - \$100

Quinceañeras - \$100

Estos nuevos montos sugeridos entran en vigor con los eventos que ocurran a partir del 1 de julio de 2024. No se aplican retroactivamente a aquellos que ya han pagado la cantidad apropiada para un próximo evento (incluso uno que caiga después del 1 de julio de 2024). La nueva estructura de tarifas se aplicará a todas las nuevas solicitudes que recibamos para eventos que tengan lugar a partir del 1 de julio de 2024.

Como siempre, si alguien no puede ofrecer el estipendio, la parroquia siempre está feliz de proporcionar el sacramento o servicio sin costo alguno.

Let us take the time to consider and make the effort to learn what it's really like to be a migrant or a refugee--without shelter, without food, without protection.

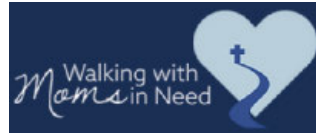

Walking with Moms

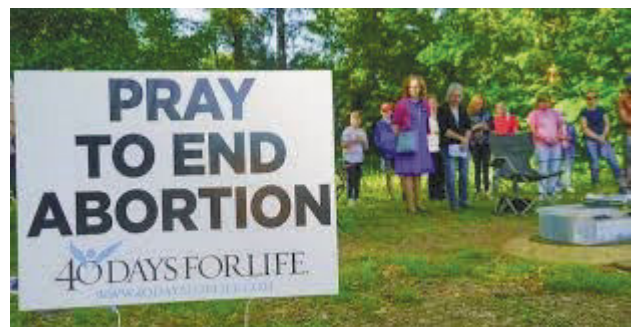

Assistive Listening Systems Available

Are you hearing impaired? Assistive Listening System Receivers are available for people who have difficulty hearing in the church or the chapel. You can request one from an usher.

This system has two options:

- 1) You can use the Receiver with headphones (either bring your own, or use ours). Or...
- 2) You can use the Receiver with a loop that goes around your neck and connects directly to the T-coil of your hearing aids.

If you are unsure if your hearing aid has this capability, your audiologist can advise you how to switch your hearing aid on and off the T-coil mode.

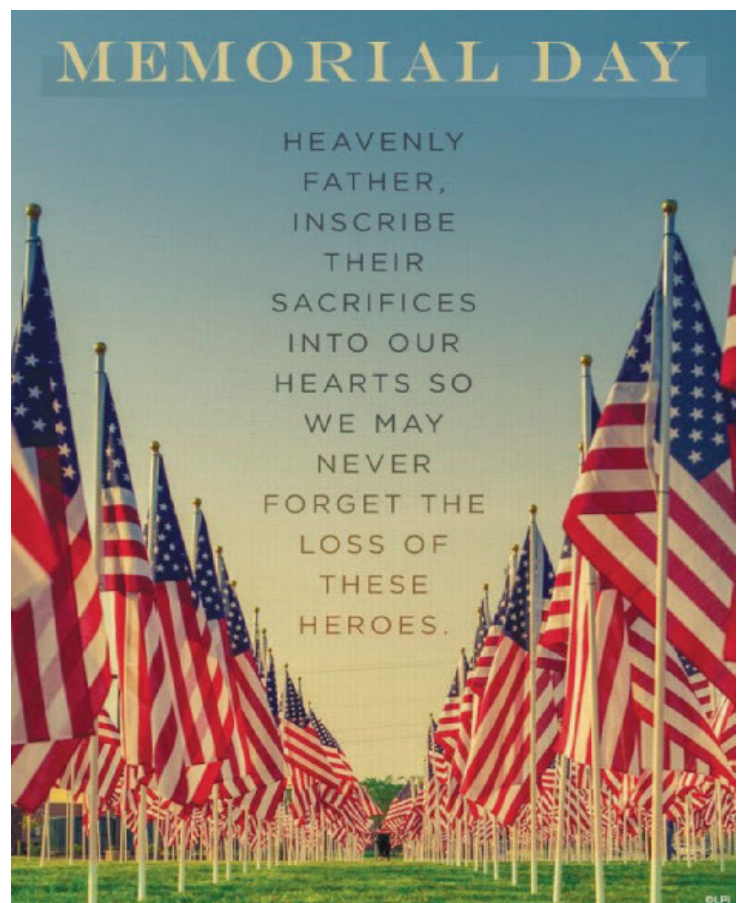


Medical Emergencies

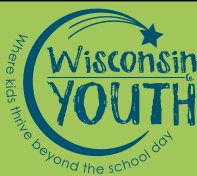
