Reflection: Mark 3:20-35 by Dcn. Jerome Buhman

“He is out of his mind.” This is what some of Jesus’ relatives said about him as he preached the Gospel; they wanted to seize him and take him away. In some ways, this might make some sense – much of what he preached was pretty radical, and his relatives might have wanted to distance themselves from him. But despite this type of pressure, Jesus continued his teaching. In some ways, we are under the same sort of pressure from those around us as we continue our mission of preaching the Good News; there are many who might say that we are out of our minds. But we are compelled, as Paul tells us in the second reading today: “We too believe, and therefore we speak.” Paul also reminds us that we should not get discouraged in our mission despite difficulties, as the reward will outweigh any obstacles we encounter. So with faith and hope let us continue to persevere in the good work to which we are called!



Words from Fr. Brian Wilk Parochial Administrator

This weekend we return to the numbered Sundays in Ordinary Time until the beginning of Advent on December 1st. In today’s Gospel, Jesus’ early ministry conflicts with those who think they know him. He teaches by telling stories through metaphor to get his listeners to think beyond what they believe they know. The same is true for all of us today. In our faith life we need to challenge ourselves to “think outside of the box.” Ordinary Time is not a time to be ordinary or set in our ways when it comes to faith and discipleship. It needs to be a time of growth and discernment in our life with God. Let’s take up the challenge!

Here are a few pastorate updates. At the direction of Bishop Hying, the Hispanic communities at St. John’s in Waunakee and at St. Thomas Aquinas will be combining into one on July 1st. They will be based at St. Thomas Aquinas. Fr. Osvaldo Briones, who currently serves the Waunakee community, has been appointed chaplain to the combined community and will be serving them on a full-time basis. Having a Spanish speaking priest as part of the pastorate will be a big plus. There are a few logistical details that are still being worked out. More will be said about this in the next few weeks.

After discussion among the priests and with staff, we are going to make a Mass schedule change at St. Thomas Aquinas beginning on July 11th. **The Thursday 7:30AM Mass will be moved to 8:30AM.** The reality is that the attendance at 7:30 is considerably lower than the other weekday Masses. We also see an advantage in having the morning Masses at the same time throughout the week. Again, **this begins on July 11th.**

On a personal note, beginning next Saturday, June 15th, I will be away with family in northern Wisconsin until June 21st. It is a time for me to recharge and hopefully catch some fish. I am sure that I will have some fish stories to tell when I return! Keep me in your prayers.

Have a blessed week. Remember, do not be ordinary in your faith. Live it!

ParishStaq will replace our current platform ParishSOFT as our new digital hub for parish information, registration, updates, and financial giving. It's a dynamic Catholic Church management system that will also integrate with our new payment and giving software: **PushPay**.

Why should I enroll in PushPay?

- PushPay is an online giving platform and will replace our current online giving platforms like PayPal and SQUARE.
- Create a PushPay account and manage your online giving throughout the year!
- Make a donation with a credit or debit card or link your bank account to give via ACH direct debit
- Set up recurring donations without having to write a check or bring an envelope to Mass
- Make a one-time gift or give to a special fund or collection
- View your giving history and giving statements
- Manage your payment methods and edit your recurring payment amount at any time



How to Enroll:

- If you would like to keep giving by envelopes or cash in the offertory basket, there is nothing you need to do at this time.
- **If you currently give online (or would like to start), you are invited to enroll with PushPay.** Scan the QR code to begin with PushPay or visit stamadison.org/donate
 - ◊ If you currently give online via PayPal, Square or ACH monthly autopay, contact the Business Office for help canceling your current recurring payment to avoid duplicate payments.

Este fin de semana volvemos a los domingos numerados del Tiempo Ordinario hasta el comienzo del Adviento, el 1 de diciembre.

En el Evangelio de hoy, el ministerio inicial de Jesús entra en conflicto con quienes creen conocerle. El enseña contando historias mediante metáforas para conseguir que sus oyentes piensen más allá de lo que creen saber. Lo mismo ocurre hoy con todos nosotros. En nuestra vida de fe necesitamos retornos a nosotros mismos a "pensar más allá". El Tiempo Ordinario no es un tiempo para ser ordinarios o aferrarnos a nuestras costumbres en lo que se refiere a la fe y el discipulado. Tiene que ser un tiempo de crecimiento y discernimiento en nuestra vida con Dios. ¡Aceptemos el reto!

He aquí algunas actualizaciones del Pastorado. Bajo la dirección del Obispo Hying, las comunidades hispanas de San Juan en Waunakee y Santo Tomás de Aquino se unirán en una sola el 1 de julio. La sede de la comunidad será Santo Tomas de Aquino. El P. Osvaldo Briones, que actualmente sirve a la comunidad de Waunakee, ha sido nombrado capellán de la comunidad combinada y les servirá a tiempo completo. Contar con un sacerdote de habla hispana como parte del Pastorado será una gran ventaja. Hay algunos detalles logísticos que todavía se están resolviendo. Tendremos más detalles en las próximas semanas.

Después de la discusión entre los sacerdotes y con el personal, vamos a hacer un cambio de horario de Misa en Santo Tomás de Aquino a partir del 11 de julio. La misa de los jueves a las 7:30am se trasladará a las 8:30am. La realidad es que la asistencia a las 7:30am es considerablemente menor comparada con las otras Misas semanales. También vemos una ventaja en tener las Misas matutinas a la misma hora durante toda la semana. De nuevo, esto comienza el 11 de julio.

En lo personal, a partir del próximo sábado 15 de junio, estaré con mi familia en el norte de Wisconsin hasta el 21 de junio. Es un tiempo para recargar las pilas y, con suerte, pescar algo. Estoy seguro de que tendré algunas historias de pesca que contar a mi regreso. Ténganme presente en sus oraciones.

Pero estamos obligados, como nos dice San Pablo en la segunda lectura de hoy: "También nosotros creemos, y por eso hablamos". Pablo también nos recuerda que no debemos desanimarnos en nuestra misión a pesar de las dificultades, pues la recompensa superará cualquier obstáculo que encontremos. Así pues, con fe y esperanza, sigamos perseverando en la buena obra a la que hemos sido llamados!

Estos nuevos montos sugeridos entran en vigor con los eventos que ocurran a partir del 1 de julio de 2024. No se aplican retroactivamente a aquellos que ya han pagado la cantidad apropiada para un próximo evento (incluso uno que caiga después del 1 de julio de 2024). La nueva estructura de tarifas se aplicará a todas las nuevas solicitudes que recibamos para eventos que tengan lugar a partir del 1 de julio de 2024.

Como siempre, si alguien no puede ofrecer el estipendio, la parroquia siempre está feliz de proporcionar el sacramento o servicio sin costo alguno.

Help Care for Creation by Eliminating Food Waste

“It has been estimated that if food waste was a country, it would be the third highest emitter of greenhouse gases after the US and China, according to the Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO) of the

United Nations. One third of greenhouse emissions globally come from agriculture, and 30% of the food we produce is wasted – about 1.8 billion tons of it a year. If, as a planet, we stopped wasting food altogether, we’d eliminate 8% of our total emissions.

Of course, individual households aren’t to blame for all of this waste. A 2018 study found that about a third of our fruits and vegetables are rejected for being the wrong size or shape before it even reaches the super-market shelf, for example.”¹

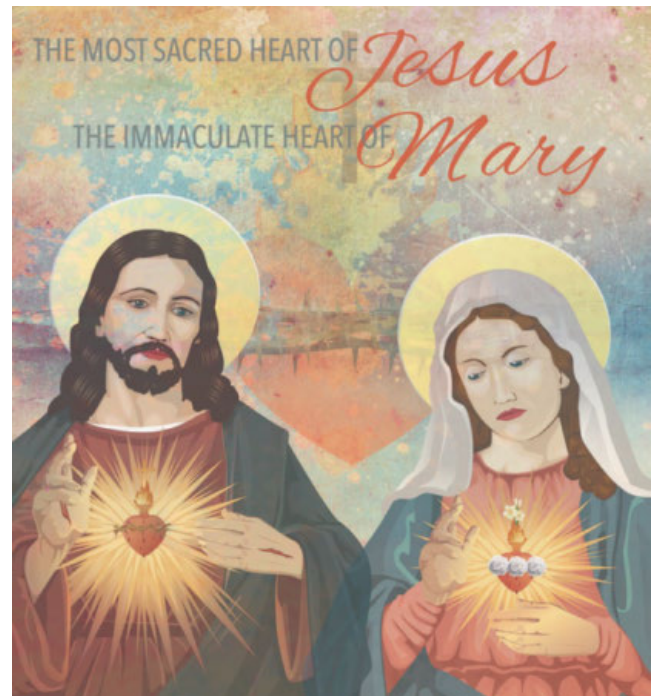
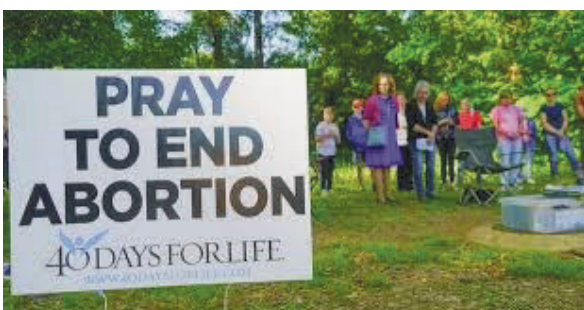
And yet, individual households can do a lot simply by being intentional and acting on God’s call to “keep” the garden. Do we eat everything on our plate? Do we store leftovers and eat them before they rot? Do we look for the perfect fruits and vegetables and leave the imperfect to rot? Do we glean excess produce from farmers markets and take them to food pantries? Do we find alternatives to throwing food waste in the garbage? Have we explored composting? Read more about it and consider how you can decrease your food waste.


